provides **accurate public health information** from the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Local Health Departments, and other reliable sources



supports state and local **public health emergency preparedness and response efforts** including *Planning and assessment *Disease surveillance and investigation *Data collection and sharing *Emergency communications *Community education and outreach and *Workforce training
