PROPOSED REPEALS: N.J.A.C. 13:31A-2.2, 2.4, AND 3.3

9. Board to review the proposed repeals of several rules because the time has expired for applicants for licensure to avail themselves of the grandfathering or waiver of examination options. N.J.A.C. 13:31A-2.2 sets forth the grandfathering option for licensure as a locksmith and provides that an applicant for a locksmith license who applies prior to September 15, 2004 shall be granted a license if he or she satisfies the requirements set forth in the rules. N.J.A.C. 13:31A-2.3 and 3.3 provides for a waiver of the locksmith or alarm examination, respectively, for applicants who satisfy the requirements of the rules and who apply by July 13, 2004.
