Francine Widrich, Acting Executive Director, was present from 9:00 A.M. until the close of the meeting.

Kathleen Moran, Administrative Assistant, III, was present from 9:00 A.M. until the close of the meeting.

Joseph Donofrio, Deputy Attorney General, Division of Law, was present from 9:00 A.M. until the close of the meeting.

Also in attendance was David Freed, Executive Director, Board of Accountancy and Court Reporting.

The Board saluted the Flag.

Note: A quorum was not present. All actions are to be ratified at the Board's next meeting to be held on June 3, 2015, or soon thereafter.

May 6, 2015

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve (11) Initial Licenses effective May 6, 2015 to March 31, 2018.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve (16) Initial Business Permits effective May 6, 2015 to March 31, 2018.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve (13) Initial Business Permits Previously Expired effective May 6, 2015 to March 31, 2018.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve (21) Changes in Business Permits effective May 6, 2015 to March 31, 2018.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve the Minutes of the 894th Open Session Business meeting held January 7, 2015.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve the Minutes of the 895th Open Session Business meeting held February 4, 2015.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve the Minutes of the 896th Open Session Business meeting held March 4, 2015.

David Freed introduced Francine Widrich who will serve as Acting Executive Director for the Board on an interim basis.

Mr. Schooley welcomed Francine.

Postal Money Order in the amount of \$100.00 received from Christian F. Rupp, IV, License #8149, t/a CR Electrical Contracting, as the twentieth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,700.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9 and N.J.S.A. 56:8-1 et seq. Payments started November 14, 2012 and the balance due is \$500.00.

The Committee accepted the payment.

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Personal Money Order in the amount of \$750.00 received from Darryl Gayton, License #11140, t/a Ampere Electric, as the second and final installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.2. Payments started April 11, 2014.

The Committee accepted the payment.

The Committee reviewed an Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Shayna Bramley, RAB Lighting, requesting approval of a new course.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve one (1) new course and instructors. Additionally, Ms. Bramley will be advised that the Committee is only approving five (5) hours of the nine and one half (9½) hour course. Licensed electrical contractors must attend all 9½ hours in order to receive a certificate for the renewal of their license.

The Committee reviewed an Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Larry Reed, ZKAccess, requesting approval of a new course.

The Committee unanimously recommended to refer Mr. Reed's application to the Fire Alarm, Burglar Alarm, Locksmith Advisory Committee. If approved by the FBL Committee, licensed electrical contractors who attend this course can receive credit for the renewal of their license.

The Committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Ramon Lopez, Electrical Training Course, requesting the approval of new instructors to teach previously approved courses.

The Committee unanimously recommended that a letter be sent to Mr. Lopez advising him that his request is being held in abeyance pending receipt of an outline for each course he wishes the new instructors to teach.

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The Committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Doug Chapman, HalfMoon Education, Inc., requesting approval of a new course.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve one (1) new course and instructor. Additionally, Mr. Chapman will be advised that the Board does not approve half hour courses. Therefore, the course listed for 6.5 hours has been approved as a six (6) hour course.

Mr. Constantinos Papademas recused himself from the following discussion and recommendation as he is one of the instructors seeking approval to teach courses for the Department of Community Affairs.

The Committee reviewed an Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from John Delesandro, NJ Department of Community Affairs/Rutgers University, requesting approval of new courses and previously approved courses.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve nine (9) new courses and instructors.

The Committee reviewed an Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Mark Quinn requesting approval of one new course.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve one (1) new course and instructor.

E-mail received March 10, 2015, from Mark Juliano, License #9630 (Inactive), t/a Juliano Electric, LLC, requesting an extension to complete his Continuing Education Courses required for the 2015 triennial renewal period.

Mr. Juliano stated he is also a licensed electrical subcode official and because of his work load and under staffing, he has not been able to complete his 34 hours of continuing education. Mr. Juliano also stated he has completed the ten hours of code and law and one eight hour course.

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The Committee unanimously recommended that Mr. Juliano's License #9630 be reactivated upon receipt of a completed Application to Reactive an Inactive Electrical Contractor's License, the proper fee, and copies of the 34 hours of Continuing Education Course certificates for the 2015 triennial renewal cycle.

Letter dated March 17, 2015, received from Derek E. DiRocco, License #15148, t/a Priority Power Company, Inc., requesting an extension to complete his Continuing Education Courses required for the 2015 triennial renewal period.

Mr. DiRocco stated he is the sole care giver for his wife who was diagnosed with cancer in August 2014. Mr. DiRocco also stated he would have been able to complete his continuing education; however, his wife's surgery is scheduled in March 2015.

The Committee unanimously recommended that Mr. DiRocco's request be held in abeyance pending receipt of a note from his wife's physician indicating that she is in need of constant care. Upon receipt of same, Mr. DiRocco will have until September 30, 2015 to take his courses.

Letter dated March 1, 2015, received from Leon Fraser, License #8103, t/a Fraser Electrical Services, requesting a waiver of the Continuing Education Courses required for the 2015 renewal period pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7(g) due to health reasons.

The Committee unanimously recommended that Mr. Fraser's request be held in abeyance pending receipt of medical documentation concerning his health. Additionally, Mr. Fraser will be reminded that he has not responded to the Provisional Order of Discipline filed January 7, 2015.

Letter received on April 2, 2015, from Kevin Graney, License #14678, requesting an extension to complete his Continuing Education Courses for the 2015 cycle which he was unable to complete due to health reasons. The Board also reviewed the letter from Joseph J. Bevacqua, Sponsor #ECSP 100, stating he will personally conduct all required course hours in Mr. Graney's home.

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The Committee unanimously recommended that a letter be sent to Mr. Graney advising him that his request is granted and he has an additional six (6) months in which to take his courses. Mr. Graney will be requested to send copies of his certificates to the Board office.

Mr. Flaherty stated for the record that Mr. Mangelli was an employee of his company approximately twelve (12) years ago.

E-mail dated March 19, 2015, received from Nicholas Mangelli, License #15080, requesting an extension to complete his Continuing Education Courses for the 2015 renewal cycle.

The Committee unanimously recommended that a letter be sent to Mr. Mangelli advising him that his request is denied. In order to reinstate License #15080, Mr. Mangelli must complete and return the Application for Reinstatement and provide proof of having completed the mandatory continuing education hours required for the renewal of his license.

E-mail dated May 4, 2015, received from Christina Martinez, Office Manager, on behalf of Joseph Battaglio, License #2742, t/a Joseph Battaglio Electrical Contracting, LLC, requesting an extension to complete his Continuing Education Courses for the 2015 renewal cycle.

The Committee unanimously recommended that a letter be sent to Mr. Battaglio advising him that he must send in a written, signed and sealed request, addressed to the Board, explaining why he was unable to complete the 34 hours of continuing education courses. Additionally, Mr. Battaglio is to include copies of continuing education course certificates he has taken to date.

Letter received April 27, 2015, from Lawrence S. Cross, 3rd, Instructor #102, requesting 15 hours of credit towards the renewal of his License #9908 pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7. Mr. Cross has provided copies of attendance certification sheets reflecting that he has taught 72 hours of continuing education courses.

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The Committee unanimously recommended that a letter be sent to Mr. Cross, License #9908, advising him that he has been granted 15 credits towards his 2015 triennial license renewal pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7.

Letter dated February 24, 2015, received from Alan M. Golub, President, Mira Lighting & Electric Service, Inc., requesting a six-month continuance of business under Permit #3859 according to N.J.S.A. 45:5A-14. The licensee, Murray J. Golub, died on September 16, 2014.

The Committee unanimously recommended that a letter be sent to Mr. Golub denying his request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9 a licensee shall not be entitled to qualify more than one person for a business permit. Office files reflect Mr. Golub endorses his Business Permit #7264 to Modern Electric Company. Therefore, his request to qualify the business under permit #3859 is denied. Unless another person with experience in the electrical field submits a request to continue the business, Mira Lighting and Electric Service, Inc. must cease and desist from engaging in the business of electrical contracting in the State of New Jersey under Business Permit #3859 and is directed to forward to this office the seal press assigned to Murray J. Golub, License #3859.

Response received from Eugene Boetius, License #13728, to the Provisional Order of Discipline ordering he pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$10,000.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9; license and business permit #13728 is provisionally suspended until such time as he appears before the Board concerning this matter; cease and desist from engaging in the business of electrical contracting until such time as he reinstates his business permit; and return his pressure seal issued to Bolyn Corporation.

This matter is being held in abeyance.

Oral arguments on the exceptions received from Susan Brown-Peitz, Deputy Attorney General, Division of Law, in the matter of Joseph C. Chickachop, License #4341, were not heard on this date as a quorum was not present.

This matter will be rescheduled for Thursday, May 14, 2015 at 10:00 A.M.

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Letter dated April 17, 2015 received from Anthony T. Urbanik, Electrical Subcode Official, Township of Scotch Plains, stating the Township of Scotch Plains received a memorandum from Stephen Jones, Construction Official, Township of Millburn, providing new guidelines for the installation of new and/or replacement of HVAC systems.

The Committee unanimously recommended that a letter be sent to Mr. Urbanik advising him pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:32A-1.2 (10) HVACR contractors can perform work as follows:

In replacement cases only, the connection of the wiring from an equipment service disconnect box of adequate size to accommodate pneumatic and/or direct digital controls and control piping of automatic oil, gas, coal burning, or any other product of combustion equipment, mechanical refrigeration equipment, gasoline, or diesel oil dispensing equipment previously dedicated to that equipment, as long as the heating or cooling capacity of each piece of equipment is 25 tons or less; the voltage of the system is 240 volts or less; and the connection of the wiring is performed according to all relevant provisions in the Uniform Construction Code.

Neil J. Marascio, License #11719 (Expired), appeared before the Board at 10:00 A.M. concerning his request to reinstate License #11719 which expired on March 31, 1997.

Mr. Marascio stated he did not renew his license because he and his brother opened an electrical contracting company together utilizing his brother's license number. Mr. Marascio also stated he thought he inactivated his license and let his wife take care of the paperwork. Mr. Marascio further stated during this time, he had moved a few times, but never provided the Board with a forwarding address and in turn the license lapsed.

Mr. Schooley asked Mr. Marascio if he was aware that the Board must be made aware of a change of address within ten days of such change?

Mr. Marascio stated he was not aware of such a law.

Mr. Marascio also stated he did not realize the license had expired until 1997. Mr. Marascio stated his only fault was not shelving properly.

Mr. Marascio stated he would like to reinstate his license and open his own business as his brother would like to become an electrical inspector.

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Mr. Marascio stated he did not utilize his seal during the period his license was expired.

Mr. Marascio also stated as an employee of his brother's company, he would run the job, estimate the job, layout the job, and perform the electrical work. Mr. Marascio further stated the company is currently wiring a 22,000 square foot home, and has also worked on new construction, large services and commercial work.

The Committee spent time asking Mr. Marascio questions regarding the electrical work he performs on a daily basis. The Committee also gave Mr. Marascio different electrical scenarios and asked that he answer questions regarding wire size; ground rods; conduit; bonding; distribution panels; metal or plastic piping; etc.

Mr. Marascio stated he has always completed the continuing education courses each renewal cycle including the current cycle.

Mr. Marascio also stated he is not trying to make excuses and has always worked with integrity and has never misrepresented his license. Mr. Marascio further stated he apologizes to the Board and hopes that the Board sees he is worthy of getting back his license.

Mr. Schooley advised Mr. Marascio he must immediately return to the Board office his pressure seal as it is the property of the Board.

Complete information is contained in the court transcript which may be provided by Caryn Speizer, CSR, Class Act Reporting Agency, 133 H Gaither Drive, Suite H, Mt. Laurel, New Jersey, 08054.

The Committee unanimously recommended to go into Executive Closed Session to discuss Mr. Marascio's request.

After discussion in Executive Closed Session the Committee returned to Open Session and made the following recommendation:

The Committee unanimously recommended that Mr. Marascio's License #11719 be reinstated as long as Mr. Marascio returns his pressure seal issued to Neil Marascio Electric and completed Application for Reinstatement.

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The Board reviewed applications for the licensing examination to be administered by PSI Services, LLC. Nineteen (19) applications were approved.

The Committee unanimously recommended to go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.
