Kathleen Moran, Administrative Assistant, III, was present from 9:00 A.M. until the close of the meeting.

Susan Berger, Deputy Attorney General, Division of Law, was present from 9:00 A.M. until the close of the meeting.

The Board saluted the Flag.

The Minutes of the 793 Meeting held December 7, 2005, were not available for approval by the Board.

Motion made by Mr. Joseph F. Cantalupo and seconded by Mr. Robert A. McCullough, and unanimously passed, to approve (3) Initial Licenses effective January 4, 2006 to March 31, 2006.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Robert A. McCullough, and unanimously passed, to approve (3) Initial Business Permits effective January 4, 2006 to March 31, 2006.

Motion made by Mr. Joseph F. Cantalupo and seconded by Mr. Robert A. McCullough, and unanimously passed, to approve (5) Initial Business Permits Previously Expired effective January 4, 2006 to March 31, 2006.

Motion made by Mr. Joseph F. Cantalupo and seconded by Mr. Robert A. McCullough, and unanimously passed, to approve (1) Change in Business Permit effective January 4, 2006 to March 31, 2006.

Postal Money Order in the amount of \$300.00 received from John J. Helmstetter, License #7192, as the eighteenth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$7,500.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9 and N.J.S.A. 56:8-1 et seq. Payments started June 7, 2004 and the balance due is \$2,100.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$500.00 received from Eli Cohen, License #206, as the second installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,500.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.5 and N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3(a). Payments started October 18, 2005 and the balance due is \$1,500.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$25.00 received from Nick Ortense, Unlicensed, as the third installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9 and N.J.S.A. 56:8-1 et seq. Payments started October 18, 2005 and the balance due is \$925.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

The Board reviewed an application for reinstatement received from Chet Antoniewicz as he failed to renew his License #7328 for the 1997 to 2000; 2000 to 2003; and 2003 to 2006 triennial renewal periods.

Motion made by Mr. Robert A. McCullough and seconded by Joseph F. Cantalupo, and passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. Antoniewcz advising him that the Board has voted to reinstate his license #7328 with the payment of the proper fees and completion of the remaining 16 hours of continuing education courses.

Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, Mr. Contantinos Papademas and Mr. James H. Flaherty were not in favor of the motion.

The sub-committee reviewed additional information received from Kevin Martin who provided the Board with a detailed description of the course entitled NFPA 72 Fire Alarm Code. Mr. Martin also stated that he will be teaching the Power Point presentations.

Mr. Martin's request was held in abeyance pending confirmation as to who will be teaching the Power Point presentations and outlines for the courses entitled "NFPA 72 Fire Alarm Code" and "Review of the Uniform Fire Code".

Motion made by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec and seconded by Mr. Robert A. McCullough, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. Martin advising him that his request is again being held in abeyance pending receipt of a release letter from Brookdale College allowing Mr. Martin to teach these courses. Additionally, Mr. Martin failed to provide the course outline for the course entitled "Review of the Uniform Fire Code". Mr. Martin will be further advised that the mid term and final examination, as indicated in his outline, cannot be part of the instructional hours.

The sub-committee reviewed a more detailed curriculum vitae for Dan Gannon which was provided by A. Alan Chech, Sponsor #038.

Mr. Chech's request to approve Mr. Gannon to teach the course entitled "Firestopping for Penetrations" was held in abeyance pending a more detailed curriculum vitae.

Motion made by Mr. Robert A. McCullough and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, that Mr. Gannon be approved to teach the course entitled "Firestopping for Penetrations".

The sub-committee reviewed Joseph E. Rossi's request to teach the Nine Hours of Code Changes and the One Hour of Laws, Rules and Regulations.

Motion made by Mr. Robert A. McCullough and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed,

that Mr. Rossi be approved to teach the Nine Hours of Code Changes and the One Hour of Laws, Rules and Regulations pending receipt of a completed Continuing Education Course/Seminar application.

The sub-committee again reviewed Anthony T. Urbanik's request to expand the approved five hour course entitled "NEC Article 250 Grounding" to a ten hour course.

Mr. Urbanik's request was held in abeyance pending a more detailed outline.

Motion made by Mr. Robert A. McCullough and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, that the following course, and instructors, is approved as submitted.

"NEC Article 250 - Grounding"

Mr. Urbanik will be reminded that this is a new ten hour course which is separate from the previously approved "NEC Article 250 - Grounding" five hour course. Mr. Urbanik will be cautioned from teaching courses before receiving final approval.

The sub-committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from David H. Schnaper, Samson Electrical Supply Co., Inc., Sponsor #103, requesting approval of new courses.

Motion made by Mr. Robert A. McCullough and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, that the following courses, and instructors, are approved as submitted.

"Commercial and Industrial Lighting Retrofits"

The sub-committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Robert Foster Smith requesting approval of new courses.

Motion made by Mr. Robert A. McCullough and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, that the following courses, and instructors, are approved as submitted.

"2005 NEC Residential Wiring"

Letter dated December 4, 2005, received from James K. Cannon, License #9011, requesting a waiver of attending the additional 24 hours of Continuing Education pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7.

Mr. Cannon stated that he was living in California to complete a year long construction project. Mr. Cannon also stated that he has completed the nine hours of code changes and the one hour of law, and did plan on completing the remaining 24 hours. However, he has now accepted a position in Florida which is to begin immediately.

Motion made by Mr. Robert A. McCullough and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. Cannon advising him that his request is denied as it does not appear that he meets the criteria pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7(g) the Board may waive the continuing education requirements for reasons of hardship, such as severe illness, disability, or military service, or for retirement of the license. Mr. Cannon will also be advised that he may choose to place his license in "inactive" status when he receives his 2006 to 2009 renewal.

Central Vacuums, who would like to assist the Board in setting up a licensing procedure for the installation of central vacuum systems.

Motion made by Mr. Robert A. McCullough and seconded by Mr. Joseph F. Cantalupo, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. LaMonica advising him that the Board is unable to assist him in this endeavor. In order to set up such a procedure, he must contact his legislature to discuss the licensing of these installers which would be done by Statute.

The Board reviewed the draft Agenda for the Code Advisory Board meeting held December 9, 2005 and the approved Minutes of the Code Advisory Board Meeting held June 10, 2005 for the Department of Community Affairs, Division of Codes and Standards.

Mr. McCullough stated that he does not have anything to report as the Board meeting for December 9, 2005, was cancelled.

Signed cease and desist agreements were received from Anthony Murphy, West Orange, New Jersey and Edward Gilchrist, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

The Board accepted the signed cease and desist agreements.

Mrs. Cook advised the Board that she will soon start compiling the list of approved continuing education courses. Each sponsor will receive a list of their approved courses and will be asked to mark which courses they would like permission to teach again for the 2006 to 2009 triennial renewal period.

The Board reviewed applications for the written examination to be administered by Thomson Prometric. Fortynine (49) applications were approved.

Motion made by Mrs. Connie F. Calisti and seconded by Mr. Richard T. Aicher, Jr., and unanimously passed, that the Board go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.
