Motion made by Mr. Richard T. Aicher, Jr. and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve (19) Initial Licenses effective July 7, 2010 to March 31, 2012.

Motion made by Mr. Richard T. Aicher, Jr. and seconded by Mr. James H. Flaherty, and unanimously passed, to approve (21) Initial Business Permits effective July 7, 2010 to March 31, 2012.

Motion made by Mr. Richard T. Aicher, Jr. and seconded by Mr. James H. Flaherty, and unanimously passed, to approve (7) Initial Business Permits Previously Expired effective July 7, 2010 to March 31, 2012.

Motion made by Mr. Richard T. Aicher, Jr. and seconded by Mr. James H. Flaherty, and unanimously passed, to approve (12) Changes in Business Permits effective July 7, 2010 to March 31, 2012.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, to approve the Minutes of the 844th Open Session Business Meeting held June 2, 2010, with the following correction:

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Motion made by Mr. Richard T. Aicher, Jr. and seconded by Mr. Joseph F. Cantalupo, and unanimously passed, that the Board go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other **public** action.

The Board elected a Chairman for the year July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:5A-5.

Mr. Richard T. Aicher, Jr. nominated Mr. Joseph P. Schooley, and the nomination was seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas.

Let the record reflect that Mr. Schooley has been elected Chairman for the Board from this date until the July 2011 meeting.

Cashier's Check in the amount of \$3,500.00 received from Joseph C. Chickachop, License #4847, t/a Chick-A-Chop Electrical Contractors, as the first and final payment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,500.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.2 and N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.3.

The Board accepted the payment.

Cashier's Check in the amount of \$1,000.00 received from Sidney Powlett, License #11493, t/a Budget Electric, as the first and final payment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.5(e) and N.J.S.A. 45:5A-15.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$25.00 received from Frank D'Arpa, License #11493, Inactive, as the fiftieth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,500.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9 and N.J.S.A. 56:8-1 et seq. Payments started September 25, 2002 and the balance due is \$1,250.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$105.00 received from William J. Passione, License #11485, t/a B Passione Electric, as the sixth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,500.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9; N.J.S.A. 56:8-1 et seq; and N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.2. Payments started February 4, 2010 and the balance due is \$2,895.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$100.00 received from Richard J. Smith, Unlicensed, as the second installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9 and N.J.S.A. 56:8-1 et seq. Payments started April 1, 2010 and the balance due is \$800.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Letter dated June 29, 2010, received from Ann A. Beggs requesting an additional six-month continuance of business under Permit #1789 according to N.J.S.A. 45:5A-14. The licensee, George R. Beggs, died on June 9, 2008.

Mrs. Beggs stated that her son must retake the electrical contractor's examination.

Office files reflect that Beggs Electrical Contractors has been granted two six-month extensions and one three-month extension.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mrs. Beggs advising her that Beggs Electrical Company has been granted one additional month so that she may hire a licensed electrical contractor who holds a business permit, to continue the business for Beggs Electrical Company. Mrs. Beggs will also be advised that as of July 31, 2010, Beggs Electrical Company must cease and desist from engaging in the business of electrical contracting and return the pressure seal issued to Beggs Electrical Company, Business Permit #1789.

The sub-committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Dina Pomarico, Phoenix & Associates, LLC.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, to approve (16) new courses and instructors.

The sub-committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Kennie M. Fried, Warshauer Electric Supply Company.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, to approve two (2) new courses and instructors.

The sub-committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from George Dzurina, G-Crew, LLC.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, to approve (1) new course and instructor, including Mr. Dzurina's request to add a new instructor to previously approved courses.

Charles Manning, Regulatory Analyst, Division of Consumer Affairs, appeared before the Board to discuss the scope of practice of master HVACR contractors.

Mr. Manning stated that he wanted the Board's input concerning language in the definition of HVAC contractors. Mr. Manning also stated that the following section deals with a possible conflict:

and in replacement cases only, the connection thereof of the wiring from an electrical service disconnect box of adequate size to accommodate the equipment and controls and previously dedicated to that equipment

Mr. Aicher stated that the language should state "the replacement of like equipment". Mr. Aicher also stated that if the replacement is identical, the HVACR contractor can perform this work.

Mr. Schooley stated that the HVACR contractor can perform this work as long as the work is performed in residential circumstances, or for single phase units, and the voltage amperages are identical and there is an existing disconnect.

Mr. Manning stated that temperature control systems are part of the HVAC regulation.

Mr. Aicher stated that the language should reflect that electrical control systems less then ten volts would be considered exempt.

Mr. Manning stated that he will draft language for the Board's review.

E-mail dated June 3, 2010, received from John R. Smith, License #8082 stating that he is in the process of selling a unit that will allow consumers to save 10% to 30% on their electric bill. In order to prove this, he would like to temporarily hook up the unit to a breaker in a main panel. A Dranetz meter will be set up to measure power quality and power consumption. A 48 hour test is conducted (24 hours on and 24 hours off). The unit and meter are then disconnected and put back in the trailer for the next site. Mr. Smith is asking if a business permit issued by the Board is required for the temporary hook up.

Motion made by Mr. Richard T. Aicher, Jr. and seconded by Mr. James H. Flaherty, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. Smith advising him that the testing, servicing, or repairing refers to previously installed equipment by a licensed electrical contractor. Based on Mr. Smith's description, it does not appear that he is just testing previously installed equipment, it appears that he is installing the equipment. Therefore, based on the description of the work to be performed, this work must be performed by a licensed electrical contractor with a valid business permit.

E-Mail dated July 1, 2010, received from Joseph Bacek asking what type of license is required when installing a telecommunication enclosure as a strand mount or directly on the pole.

The Board directed that a letter be sent to Mr. Bacek requesting a more detailed description of the work to be performed as some of the work may be subject to licensure.

Signed cease and desist agreement received from Igor Kniazev, Wantage, New Jersey.

The Board accepted the signed cease and desist agreement.

The Board reviewed applications for the written examination to be administered by Thomson Promectric. Sixteen (16) applications were approved.

Based on the recent changes affecting Board Members, the following modifications were made by the Board concerning the scheduling of Investigative Inquiries:

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, that the Investigative Inquiries scheduled for July 21, 2010 be rescheduled for August 4, 2010.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, that Investigative Inquiries will now be heard at regular scheduled Board meetings. The Board meetings will be held from 9:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M.

Motion made by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec and seconded by Mr. James H. Flaherty, and unanimously passed, that the Board go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other public action.
