

871<sup>st</sup> BUSINESS MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EXAMINERS  
OF ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS (PUBLIC SESSION)  
NOVEMBER 7, 2012

The Committee Minutes of November 7, 2012, have not been formally approved and are subject to change or modification by the Public Body at its next meeting of December 5, 2012, or soon thereafter as it may be considered. All requirements of the "Open Public Meetings Act" have been complied with according to N.J.S.A. 10:4-6.

The notice of the meeting has been mailed to the Newark Star Ledger, Camden Courier Post, and the Trenton Times, and also notice has been posted on the Bulletin Board at the office of the Secretary of State, Trenton, New Jersey.

Committee meeting of November 7, 2012, was called to order at 9:00 A.M. The following members were present:

David Freed, Acting Executive Director, was present from 9:00 A.M. until the close of the meeting.

Kathleen Moran, Administrative Assistant 3, was present from 9:00 A.M. until the close of the meeting.

Joseph Donofrio, Deputy Attorney General, Division of Law, was present from 9:00 A.M. until the close of the meeting.

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The Committee saluted the Flag.

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**Note:** A quorum was not present. All actions are to be ratified at the Board's next meeting to be held on December 5, 2012, or soon thereafter.

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November 7, 2012

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve (18) Initial Licenses effective November 7, 2012 to March 31, 2015.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve (16) Initial Business Permits effective November 7, 2012 to March 31, 2015.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve (11) Initial Business Permits Previously Expired effective November 7, 2012 to March 31, 2015.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve (5) Changes in Business Permits effective November 7, 2012 to March 31, 2015.

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Joseph P. Schooley, Chairman, signed on this date, a Provisional Order of Discipline ordering that Mr. Saganski pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.2. Additionally, Mr. Saganski's License and Business Permit #4254 are to be provisionally suspended until such time as he responds to the Board.

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Joseph P. Schooley, Chairman, signed on this date a Consent Order reducing the amount of the civil penalty issued against Jose Lopes to \$500.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9. Mr. Lopes is requested to sign an agreement to cease and desist from advertising his availability to engage in the business of electrical contracting in the State of New Jersey until such time as he becomes licensed to do so. Mr. Lopes is advised that should he take and pass the electrical contractor's examination, a license and business permit will not be issued to him until such time as the civil penalty assessed against him is paid in full.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve previously approved courses and instructors.

- 10. At its October 3, 2012, the Board reviewed the application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Kenneth Cerullo, Esq, The Commercial Agency, Inc. The Board held Mr. Cerullo's request in abeyance pending clarification of the differences between the one hour, two hour, and three hour courses.

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Letter dated September 25, 2012, received from Christopher Jones, License #15818, along with copies of Continuing Education Course certificates totaling 34 hours.

Mr. Jones was granted a six-month extension to take the required 34 hours of Continuing Education.

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Letter dated September 21, 2012, received from William G. Leach, Jr., License #4581, along with copies of Continuing Education Course certificates totaling 34 hours.

Mr. Leach was granted an extension to take the required 34 hours of Continuing Education. The extension expired on October 1, 2012.

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Letter dated September 16, 2012, received from Mark C. Greeley, License #14215 (Expired), requesting reinstatement of his license which he failed to renew for the triennial renewal periods of April 1, 2006 to March 31, 2009, April 1, 2009 to March 31, 2012, and April 1, 2012 to March 31, 2015.

Mr. Greeley stated that he did not renew his license due to illnesses and injuries he

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sustained during this time period.

Mr. Greeley has provided copies of Continuing Education Course certificates totaling 34 hours for the 2006 and 2009 cycles.

The Committee unanimously recommended that a letter be sent to Mr. Greeley advising him that in order to regain his License #14215 he must take and pass the electrical contractor's examination pursuant to the Uniform Enforcement Act.

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The Committee reviewed Assembly Bill No. A3394 which authorizes the professional and occupational Boards to enact rules and regulations that establish procedures to recognize continuing education approval entities that may approve continuing education courses for holders of a professional or occupational license or certificate of registration or certification to satisfy the continuing education requirements for renewal of the respective license, registration, or certificate.

The Committee does not oppose Assembly Bill No. A3394.

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E-Mail received from Tom Valeo, Electrical Sub-code Official, City of Union City, asking for a formal interpretation of who can sign an Electrical Subcode Technical Section application for companies like Verizon.

The Committee unanimously recommended that a letter be sent to Mr. Valeo advising him that it is the current position of the Committee that an employee of the exempted company, showing proper identification, may sign the permit application. The employee must also be able to provide to the inspector with the telecommunications wiring exemption number issued to that company.

Mr. Freed advised the Committee that he would like to send a letter to all Telecommunications Wiring Exemption individuals/companies asking them to update their information on file with the Board.

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E-mail dated October 19, 2012, received from Howard Shapiro, Insite Security,

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requesting clarification as to whether or not a Telecommunications Wiring Exemption certificate holder is allowed to run audio visual cabling and connect same to powered control equipment.

This matter is being held in abeyance and will be discussed at the December 5, 2012 meeting.

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Letter dated October 23, 2012, received from Bryan J. Graham, Qualified Journeyman's Registration #687, requesting a waiver of the ten hour code update course to renew his journeyman registration.

The Committee unanimously recommended that a letter be sent to Mr. Graham advising him that he will be granted an extension in order to take the required continuing education courses which will expire on January 31, 2013. However, should Mr. Graham take and pass the electrical contracting examination in January 2013, the Board will grant Mr. Graham a waiver of the Continuing Education Courses required to renew his Qualified Journeyman's Registration.

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Signed Acknowledgment and response to the Uniform Penalty Letter dated September 20, 2012, received from "Frank" offering Bradley Cohen, The Green Revolution, the opportunity to settle the matter by paying a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9.

The Committee unanimously recommended that the Uniform Penalty Letter be finalized. Additionally, the Committee directed that a letter be sent to the township requesting a copy of the Electrical Technical Subcode Technical Section application. Upon receipt of same, a letter is to be sent to the contractor of record asking what his involvement was with the work performed.

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Let the record reflect that Joseph C. Chickachop, License #4847 (Suspended), 125 Chaucer Place, Cherry Hill, New Jersey, 08003-3544, arrived for his appearance before the Board; however, because a quorum was not present, his appearance was not heard.

Mr. Chickachop was scheduled to appear before the Board regarding the Attorney

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General's Motion for Default concerning the Administrative Complaint filed on February 3, 2011.

DAG Lim stated that this matter was scheduled for a hearing before the Board regarding the Attorney General's Motion on the entry of default based on Mr. Chickachop's failure to appear at a telephone conference in July 2012 before Judge Beavers at the Office of Administrative Law. The matter was transferred from the OAL back to the Board for disposition. Mr. Chickachop had not responded to any efforts to reach him until the Attorney General filed the Motion for Default. Mr. Chickachop did telephone DAG Lim who advised Mr. Chickachop what would happen today.

DAG Lim also stated that the matter of the Attorney General's Motion was to be heard by the Board today; however, there is not a quorum and the matter is to be tabled until December 5, 2012.

DAG Lim further stated that Mr. Chickachop did come to the Board meeting today and had been prepared to oppose the Attorney General's Motion and so the fact that the motion was not heard should not be held against him.

The Committee unanimously recommended to go into Executive Closed Session to discuss the results of DAG Lim's settlement discussion with Mr. Chickachop.

After discussion the Board returned to Open Session.

Complete information is contained in the court transcript which will be provided by Laura A. Carucci, CCR, Class Act Reporting Agency, 133 H Gaither Drive, Suite H, Mt. Laurel, New Jersey, 08054.

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The Committee reviewed applications for the written examination to be administered by Thomson Prometric. Nineteen (19) applications were approved.

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The Committee unanimously recommended to go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred.

The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board

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determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.
