## 7. For Advisory Committee Review - Bill No. A4333, March 23, 2015

The Advisory Committee reviewed Senate and General Assembly Bill No. A4333, an act that exempts certain activities of alarm businesses from statutes governing the practice of locksmith and "The State Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Contracting License Law."

Specifically, the bill exempts from statutes regulating the practice of locksmithing, the activities of an alarm business performed in combination with the installation, maintenance, moving, repairing, replacing, servicing or reconfiguration of an alarm system and limited to locks or access control devices that are controlled by an alarm system control device, including the removal of existing hardware. The bill also exempts from "The State Heating, Ventilating, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Contracting License Law" an alarm business that performs or offers to perform the installation, repair, replacement, or modification of a thermostat or other temperature control interface with 60 volts or less.

A motion was made by Lt. Horner and seconded by Mr. Rible to oppose to bill No. A4333 for the following reasons:

The Advisory Committee notes that while access control devices fall within the statutory definition of those functions performed by an alarm business, mechanical locks do not. Mechanical locks are the exclusive statutory province of the licensed locksmith business. The Advisory Committee's examination and continuing education for alarm licensees does not include any information concerning mechanical locks. In addition, the Advisory Committee objects to alarm installers performing installation, repair, replacement or modification of a thermostat or other temperature control interface with 60 volts or less as they do not have any record of having knowledge or education of mechanical lock, exclusively, locksmith.

A motion was made by Mr. Sprague and seconded by Mr. Rible to close the Public Session of the meeting at 10:40 a.m. and adjourn into Executive Session for an Investigative Inquiry. Motion carried unanimously.

The Advisory Committee returned to Public Session at 11:40 a.m. to review the application from New Jersey Electric Security Association for approval of Alex Salvatore as an instructor.
