Chairman Shoremount informed Mr. Trevelise that a complaint filed with the Advisory Committee may be considered a public record if action is taken against a licensee. Therefore, the

Advisory Committee cannot ensure a complainant 's anonymity.

Mr. Trevelise asked whether the continuing education programs submitted to the Advisory Committee by the New Jersey Burglar Alarm and Fire Alarm Association have been approved. Chairman Shoremount advised Mr. Trevelise that the continuing education programs submitted have been approved but the course numbers and associated paperwork are still pending. Mr. Trevelise also inquired whether the continuing education programs that are approved would be able to be scheduled without the Committee assigned code numbers. Chairman Shoremount informed Mr. Trevelise that the continuing education programs can be scheduled and taken without the code numbers.
