# 4. INQUIRES SUBMITTED FOR BOARD DISCUSSION AND RESPONSE

a• Anthony Menafro, LMP # 9293, email inquiry of July 2, 2014, questioning the HVACR scope of practice and his need for an HVACR license. Mr. Menafro advises that he engages in steam and hot water boiler installations and does not perform HVACR or refrigeration work.

Board response: The Board stated the Mr. Menafro is not required to hold the HVACR license for the work he described and performs.

b• Michael Chokov, email of July 1, 2014, inquiry concerning the HVACR bona fide representative requirements

Board response: The Board responded by stating that the bona fide representative must be the Executive Officer in the case of the corporation as defined in the HVACR Statutes, N.J.S.A. 45:16A-2.

c• Patrick A. Stewart, Executive Director, ACCA, e-mail of June 30, 2014, requirements for a hot water boiler

Board response: The Board clarified that the installation of a hot water heater requires a Master Plumber's license.

The replacement and/or changing of a boiler does not require a Master Plumber's license. The Licensed HVACR Contractor may perform the installation of the backflow preventer provided that it is a non-testable device on a replacement boiler only in residential properties.

d• Patrick A. Stewart, Executive Director, ACCA, e-mail of June 30, 2014, questioning the task of sheet metal ductwork and HVACR license requirements

Board response: This work requires an HVACR license.

e• Douglas Donahue, email of June 24, 2014, questioning the need for an HVACR license while a lead mechanic at Merck.

Board response: An HVACR license is not required for Mr. Donahue while he employed as a lead mechanic at Merck. However, if he is a 3<sup>rd</sup> party, outside contractor hired by Merck, an HVACR license would be required.

f• John Susnosky, email of June 30, 2014, retail store proprietor, questions the requirements for an HVACR license for the installation of fireplace gas lines

Board response: Yes! The HVACR license is required for this task. Only Licensed Master Plumbers and Licensed HVACR Contractors are permitted to perform this type work.

g• Donna Burke, Sr Vice President of Operations, EJA Insurance, presents a chart of the documents required by the Board for an HVACR license with respect to a "company owner" and its employees.

Board response: The Board found the chart presented by Ms. Burke to be accurate.

h. Bryan Curtis, manages hotels in Central Jersey and performs some maintenance on PTAC wall units with in-house staff.

Board response: The Board responded that W-2 employees may perform this type work provided they have the proper education and are certified employees of that hotel. A copy of A-2456 will be provided to Mr. Curtis.

i. Lincoln Technical Institute (LTI): Jai West, email June 19, 2014
The Board suggested LTI submit supporting documents for Board review.

J. William Francesconi, Lor-Mar Mechanical Services, July 7, 2014 email Questions his need for the HVACR license while his company is a licensed plumbing contractor

Board response: The HVACR license is required for the air conditioning and refrigeration tasks as detailed within the scope of practice for HVACR.
