REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

General Report

Acting Executive Director, Joseph Grabowy, presented an invoice from NCEES representing its annual membership dues. On a motion by BM Purcell, second by BM Smith, the Board voted to authorize payment of the \$6,500 invoice from NCEES.

On a motion by BM Purcell, second by BM Smith, the Board voted to approve the Invoice for \$250.00 from the Colonial States Boards of Surveyor Registration.

Acting Executive Director Joseph Grabowy informed the Board of inquiries received regarding continuing education credits for dual licensees. After discussing this matter the Board on a motion by BM Cleary, second by BM Purcell voted to recommend to the committee, to propose a regulation that dual licensees complete a minimum of 27 credits (with two credits in ethics) for the May 1, 2010 thru April 30, 2012 licensing period.

BM Frantz announced to the Board that the Nomination Committee will begin accepting nominations for President and Vice President.

Acting Executive Director, Joseph Grabowy, stated that on March 14, 2011, representatives from this Board, namely DAG Albertson, BP Jones, VP Valenti, and BM Purcell and himself, met with representatives from the Board of Architects and several representatives from the Municipal Construction Officials Association of NJ, namely, John Fiedler, Chairman, and Elizabeth McKay of the red tape commission, and Larry DeMarzo. The purpose of the meeting was to evaluate the permit process relating to the required document submittal so that it can be streamlined by both the designers and code officials, in order to provide business applicants a more timely and efficient plan review. There will be a subsequent

meetings to further discuss this issue.

BM Purcell stated that NCEES will be moving from an ABET accreditation standard to an NCEES engineering standard when evaluating the education credentials of applicants. BM Purcell will send a correspondence to NCEES requesting an explanation on this matter.
