IV. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Dr. Walker discussed with the Board that the issue of question #6 on the renewal application asking about US citizenship, which was discussed at the July 13, 2016 meeting, is continuing to be worked on.

V. PUBLIC COMMENT

The following members of the public were present: Anthony Gallo, MSW student at Rutgers – Student Intern – NASW NJ

Mary Jean Weston, LCSW, Associate Executive Director, NASW-NJ

Ms. Weston discussed with the Board that the clinical supervision paperwork asks the clinical supervisor is asked to check if the applicant is ready or not for licensure. Many times a supervisor is leaving the agency or a supervisee is changing a supervisor and the supervisor does not want to check off that the applicant is ready for licensure when there is still more supervision to complete. Ms. Weston asked if it was possible to update the supervision form to reflect a third option which will state that the work so far is acceptable if the supervision is still in progress.

The Board will review options to ask if the work so far is satisfactory or unsatisfactory to date, and if it is not, the supervisor should send a letter indicating why not. DAG Krugman and Dr. Walker will work on the supervision form to be reviewed at a later date.

Ms. Weston also discussed with the Board agencies that are not compliant with the rules of supervision for LSWs, and they are not being supervised by someone who is fully compliant with N.J.A.C. 13:44G-8.1. An example of this was an LCSW was asked to sign off on supervision they did not provide, and when they refused to sign, they were terminated from their job. What can be done to work with organizations and agencies to ensure compliance at all times? Ms. Weston will work on a letter that can be sent to all employers with references of the proper regulations to follow and will send to DAG Krugman and Dr. Walker to review.
