(b) Prior to the issuance of the license, the Board shall have received:

The results of a criminal history record background check of the files of the Criminal Justice Information Services Division in the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the State Bureau of Identification in the Division of State Police that does not disclose a conviction for a disqualifying crime;

3. Designation of an agent in New Jersey for service of process if the applicant is not a New Jersey resident or does not have an office in New Jersey; and

4. Proof of coverage by a professional liability insurance policy in a minimum amount of \$ 1,000,000 per occurrence and \$ 3,000,000 aggregate per policy year.

13:37A-2.3 Renewal of license

(a) Licenses shall be renewed biennially on a form provided by the Board. Each applicant shall attest that:

1. The continuing education requirements at [N.J.A.C. 13:37A-4.1](#) have been completed during the prior biennial period;
2. The applicant is currently certified in CPR and use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) from courses offered by the American Heart Association or a substantially similar course approved or offered by the American Red Cross, the National Safety Council, Coyne First Aid, Inc., the Health & Safety Institute, or ProTrainings; and
3. The applicant has coverage by a professional liability insurance policy in a minimum amount of \$ 1,000,000 per occurrence and \$ 3,000,000 aggregate per policy year.

13:37A-2.4 License reactivation

(a) A licensee who holds an inactive license pursuant to [N.J.A.C. 13:37A-2.3\(d\)](#) may apply to the Board for reactivation of an inactive license. A licensee seeking reactivation of an inactive license shall submit:

- 1.-2. (No change.)
3. The active renewal fee set forth at [N.J.A.C. 13:37A-7.1](#);
4. Evidence of having completed all continuing education credits for the current biennial registration period, consistent with the requirements set forth at [N.J.A.C. 13:37A-4.1](#); and
5. Proof of coverage by a professional liability insurance policy in a minimum amount of \$ 1,000,000 per occurrence and \$ 3,000,000 aggregate per policy year.

5. The reinstatement fee set forth at [N.J.A.C. 13:37A-7.1](#);
6. Evidence of having completed all continuing education credits for the current biennial registration period, consistent with the requirements set forth at [N.J.A.C. 13:37A-4.1](#); and
7. Proof of coverage by a professional liability insurance policy in a minimum amount of \$ 1,000,000 per occurrence and \$ 3,000,000 aggregate per policy year.
