##### Notice of Continuing Education Topics

**Take notice** that the State Board of Examiners of Heating, Ventilating, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors (Board) has determined the topics that shall be part of continuing education courses taken by licensed master heating, ventilating, air conditioning, and refrigeration contractors (master HVACR contractors) during the 2023 to 2024 biennial renewal period. N.J.A.C. 13:32A-4.1 requires licensed master HVACR contractors to complete five credits of continuing education every biennial renewal period. One hour of continuing education must be in statutes and rules governing the practice of heating, ventilating, air conditioning, and refrigeration. The Board is required to determine the topics required for the remaining four hours.

The Board has determined that one hour shall be in review of the International Mechanical Code, International Fuel Gas Code, and the portions of the International Residential Code addressing Mechanical and Fuel Gas, as amended at N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.20 and 3.22, of which at least 15 minutes shall be in standards set forth in Manual "D" Residential Duct Sizing, Manual "J" Residential Load Calculations, and Manual "S" Residential Equipment Selection. The remaining three hours shall be devoted to any topic relevant to the practice of heating,

ventilating, air conditioning, and refrigeration as defined at  
N.J.A.C. 13:32A-1.2.
