Take notice that on September 12, 2021, the Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners (Board) received a petition for rulemaking from Jaime L. Gilmore, MA, LMFT, Interim President of the New Jersey Association for Marriage and Family Therapy (NJAMFT). N.J.A.C. 13:34-5.3 identifies the entities that can approve courses and programs that licensees may take in order to obtain continuing education hours, and because NJAMFT has ended its affiliation with the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy, the petitioner requested that the Board amend N.J.A.C. 13:34-5.3 to change the name "American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy of New Jersey, Inc." to the "New Jersey Association for Marriage and Family Therapy."

In accordance with applicable law, the Board reviewed the petition at its October 14, 2021 public meeting. The Board determined to refer the matter for further deliberation. A notice acknowledging receipt of the petition was published in the November 1, 2021 New Jersey Register at 53 N.J.R. 1868(a). On November 3, 2021, the petitioner withdrew the petition. Accordingly, no further action will be taken on this petition.
