Take notice that pursuant to [N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1](#), the rules at [N.J.A.C. 13:41](#) were scheduled to expire on October 18, 2024. The rules establish standards for the licensing, certification, and regulation of professional planners and planners-in-training.

Subchapter 1 addresses seal and signature standards. Subchapter 2 sets forth the rules governing misconduct. Subchapter 3 sets forth the general provisions, including fees charged by the Board of Professional Planners (Board) and the requirement that State or political subdivisions employ only licensed professional planners for certain civil service titles. Subchapter 4 sets forth the permissible division of responsibility with respect to the submission of site plans and major subdivision plats. Subchapter 5 sets forth the licensing and examination requirements for professional planners.

Subchapter 6 addresses the certification requirements for planners-in-training.

The Board has reviewed the rules and has determined them to be necessary, reasonable, and proper for the purpose for which they were originally promulgated.

Therefore, pursuant to [N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1.c\(1\)](#), these rules are readopted without change and shall continue in effect for a seven-year period.
