III. REVIEW OF MINUTES

1. August 10, 2022 Public Minutes

1. Status of Board Operations

Ms. Turner reported a new Board member has been appointed to the Board, Rosemary Browne, MSW. This appointment fills the last public member vacancy on the Board.

VI. CORRESPONDENCE

1. <u>Correspondence from the BACB regarding Equivalency Evaluation of the Pennsylvania Behavior Specialist License</u> - email dated August 11, 2022

Dr. Buchanan presented information provided by Misty Bloom, Esq. of the BACB regarding a new behavior analysis credential in Pennsylvania. This "license" acts more as a billing authorization and its requirements are far less than those of the BACB. Ms. Bloom's email urges State Boards to be mindful when licensing individuals with this credential, knowing the requirements are not equivalent to BACB certifications. This credential should be distinguished from the license that the pending PA law would introduce, which would truly provide behavior analysts in PA with a professional license.

The Board accepted this as informational.

2. <u>Correspondence from the BACB regarding Investor Owned and Operated ABA Serviced Agencies</u> - email dated August 25, 2022

Dr. Buchanan presented an email received from the BACB regarding ethical concerns surrounding the practices of investor owned and operated agencies. Specifically, the BACB informs Boards that they may encounter an increase in complaints regarding client abandonment. The BACB further explains their limits in pursuing violations against these agencies due to antitrust restrictions.

After discussion, the Board members agreed that the responsibility to protect patients in these instances would fall on the highest level clinician employed by the agency.
