SIX-MONTH EXTENSION

DOMINICK M. YANNETTA 4. Letter dated November 22, 2004, received from Dominick M. Yanetta requesting a third six-month continuance of business under permit #1109 according to N.J.S.A. 45:5A-14. The licensee, Angelo Yanetta, died on August 7, 2003.

Mr. Yannetta states that he is scheduled to retake the examination in April 2005.

The current extension expires on February 21, 2005.

CONTINUING EDUCATION

ADRIAN ESTES 5. Sub-committee to review additional information for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Adrian Estes, International Board of Environmental Health & Safety, Inc., requesting approval of new courses.

At its meeting held on October 6, 2004, the course entitled "Making Safety Work for You" was held in abeyance pending clarification of the 45 minute overlap concerning the two topics listed on the Program Agenda. Key 2 of the 5 Keys to Safety is taught from 10:15 until 11:45 and Key 3 of the 5 Keys is being taught from 11:00 until 11:45. The course entitled "OSHA 10 Hour - Construction" was denied as it does not meet the criteria of

Continuing Education which stipulates that only 8 instructional hours can be taught in one day.

GAY E. CANOUGH 6. Sub-committee to review additional information for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Gay E. Canough, ETM Solar Works, requesting approval of a new course.

At its meeting held on October 6, 2004, the course entitled "Photovoltaics (PV) Installer?s Course" was being held in abeyance pending a breakdown of the hours for each of the topics listed in the course syllabus. Dr. Canough was advised that review and study time is not to be included as part of the hours of instruction.

JOHN BIONDI 7. Sub-committee to review additional information for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from John Biondi, Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee, requesting approval of new courses.

At its meeting held October 6, 2004, Mr. Biondi?s request was again denied as some of the courses submitted do not meet the criteria of Continuing Education. Continuing Education courses are for the prime purpose of educating licensed electrical contractors. For example the course entitled "Conduit Bending and Welding" is not a course that a licensed electrical contractor would be required to attend; however, the course entitled "OSHA 10/30 Hour Training and Electrical Grounding" would be a course that meets the criteria of Continuing Education. Additionally, some of the courses submitted by Mr. Biondi do not specify exact hours; they are approximated. Mr. Biondi will also be advised to provide the Board with a more detailed breakdown and description of the course content.

ROBERT MARSHALL 8. Sub-committee to review application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Robert Marshall, Capital Community College, requesting approval of new courses.

RALPH LOMBARDI 9. Sub-committee to review application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Ralph Lombardi.

KATHLEEN L. MOSKOWITZ 10. Sub-committee to review application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Kathleen L. Moskowitz, New Jersey Electrical Contractors Association.
