## **PENALTIES**

Mr. Capodanno also states that the company has two licensed electrical contractors in its employ, both with over forty years of experience. Mr. Capodanno further states that Capodanno Electric has nineteen full time employees.

### KENNETH W. KRUG, ELECTRICAL SUBCODE OFFICIAL

8. Letter dated December 20, 2008, received from Mr. Krug requesting the Board's opinion as to whether an electrical subcode official can approve work performed by a licensed electrical contractor, or a non licensed individual, without permits, for work performed on a one or two family rental property.
