ROGER SIMONDS

Letter dated January 16, 2007, received from Mr. Simonds, Executive Director, National Electrical Contractors Association, concerning the installation of Solar Photovoltaic Array Modular Panels which emit a voltage greater than ten volts when subjected to natural or artificial light. Mr. Simonds states that the panels are being installed by unlicensed individuals.

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 3899

14. Board to review Assembly Bill No. 3899 which clarifies the requirement that a public body make its minutes "promptly available" to the public following a meeting pursuant to the "Senator Byron M. Baer Open Public Meetings Act." Under the bill, a public body would have until noon on the 30th day following the meeting at which the minutes were taken to make the minutes of the public portions of the meeting available to the public. If the public body failed to comply with this requirement and a member of the public is forced to go to the court for injunctive relief or other remedy, the court would be required to award reasonable attorney fees and court costs incurred by the person.
