FIRE ALARM, BURGLAR ALARM AND LOCKSMITH ADVISORY COMMITTEE

11. Memorandum dated February 18, 2009, received from George De Luca, Administrative Analyst, Fire Alarm, Burglar Alarm and Locksmith Advisory Committee, stating that the Township of Hamilton is denying a burglar and fire alarm permit unless a licensed electrical contractor obtains the permit. The Township indicates that an alarm contractor cannot install an earth ground without an electrical contractor's licensee. Mr. De Luca asks that the Board review proposed correspondence to be sent to the Township of Hamilton advising that fire alarm, burglar alarm and locksmiths are authorized to perform all work necessary to affect the installation of work within their respective disciplines up to and including connection to branch circuit wiring.
