Letter dated April 23, 2012, received from Mr. Hurwitz stating that his medical issues began on January 29, 2011 and since that time he has been unable to drive alone and traveling out state has been difficult. Mr. Hurwitz also states that his company does not have any open jobs in New Jersey. Mr. Hurwitz further states that he is still able to perform supervisory duties in Boston and should the opportunity arise to perform work in New Jersey, he would make other arrangements.
