CSST GAS PIPING

8. Mr. Schooley requested that the following matter be placed on the Agenda for further discussion by the Board.

At its September 5, 2012 meeting, Joseph McMullen of the Electrical Contractors Association of New Jersey, stated that some towns require an electrical contractor to obtain a permit to install CSST (corrugated stainless steel tubing) gas piping and some towns do not.

At its April 4, 2012 meeting, the Board reviewed an article regarding the installation of CSST (corrugated stainless steel tubing) gas piping. After review and discussion of the article, the Board made the following motion:

Motion made by Mr. Richard T. Aicher, Jr. and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, that although a New Jersey licensed electrical contractor is the most qualified person to perform the bonding, the Board's position is that it is not required that a licensed electrical contractor install the bonding clamps and conductor provided that the connection to the grounding electrode system is outside the service enclosure; i.e. to the electrical system grounding electrodes with the appropriate ground clamp, to the foundation rebar when the electrical system employs a Ufer ground, to the electrical system grounding electrode conductor if it is of sufficient size, to other grounding

electrodes (lightning) if integrated with the electrical system, or copper water pipe if it serves as primary grounding electrode. The Board notes that this position is applicable only for installations required to be inspected and are inspected per the State Uniform Construction Code.

CHARLES AIKEY, LICENSE #6642
