#### ASSEMBLY BILL No. 2394

5. Board to review Assembly Bill No. 2394 which changes the definition of "electronic security system" contained in the law. The definition of "electronic security system" is expanded to include access security systems, closed circuit television systems, intercom systems and other electronic monitoring devices. The Bill also establishes definitions in this law for "access control system", "closed circuit television system", "Internet protocol and any successor protocols" and "intercom systems"
