Letter dated June 14, 2012, received from Michael J. Revness, Esq., Kurtz & Revness, P.C., on behalf of John P. Cioffi who has applied to the Board to take the electrical contractors examination. Mr. Cioffi was sent a letter disapproving his application as it did not appear that he has five years of experience in compliance with the National Electrical Code.

The Board directed that Deputy Attorney General Joseph Donofrio draft a letter to be sent to Mr. Revness advising him that based on the application for examination submitted by Mr. Cioffi it does not appear that he has five years of experience in compliance with the National Electrical Code. Mr. Cioffi's hands on experience appears to be low voltage wiring.

Letter dated November 27, 2012, sent to Mr. Revness advising him that Mr. Cioffi's application for examination is disapproved as he did not possess the requisite experience requirements pursuant to $\underline{N.J.S.A}$. 45:5A-9(b) and $\underline{N.J.A.C}$. 13:31-2.1(a) (3).
