COMMUNICATIONS

N.J.A.C. 13:31-2.2(d) and (e)

- 23. Board to discuss extending the following regulations as the testing centers were closed as part of an executive order signed by the governor during the Coronavirus pandemic:
 - <u>N.J.A.C</u>. 13:31-2.2(d) if an applicant fails to obtain a passing score on all sections of the Board licensing examination within five years of the date of approval to take the examination for the first time, the application for licensure shall be deemed abandoned and closed.
 - <u>N.J.A.C</u>. 13:31-2.2(e) if an applicant fails to sit for the Board licensing examination within two years of the date of approval to take the examination for the first time, application for licensure shall be deemed abandoned and closed.

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CONTINUING EDUCATION

24. All approved Continuing Education sponsors were advised that the Board determined the entire 34 hours of continuing education required for the April 2, 2021 renewal may be presented as webinars, written, or electronic media distance learning courses. Sponsors were also advised that they must comply with the requirements of N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7(h).

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 4225

25. Board to review Assembly Bill No. 4225 which provides that, notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, lawful presence in the United States may not be required to obtain a professional or occupational license, provided that the applicant meets all other requirements for licensure.

SENATE BILL NO. 2419

26. Board to review Senate Bill No. 2419 which would regulate the installation, maintenance and repair of perimeter fence intrusion protection systems, and other alarm systems governed by The Electrical Contractors Licensing Act of 1962. The bill would also establish confidentiality standards for alarm service practitioners and licensed locksmiths. The bill would restrict local government regulation of the installation and maintenance of a perimeter fence intrusion protection system, as long as the system meets the definition of the system established by the bill and several additional requirements.

N.J.S.A. 45:5A-18(m)

- 27. Electrical work or construction which is performed on the following facilities or which is by or for the following agencies shall not be included within the business of electrical contracting so as to require the securing of a business permit under this act:
 - (m) The maintaining, installing or connecting of automatic oil, gas or coal burning equipment, gasoline or diesel oil dispensing equipment and the lighting in connection therewith to a supply of adequate size at the load side of the distribution board.
