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EDWARD JOHNSON, LICENSE #7469 (SUSPENDED)

9. Mr. Johnson has failed to respond to the Administrative Action Provisional Order of Discipline filed September 3, 2014, ordering that his License and Business Permit #7469 be provisionally revoked; he cease and desist from engaging in the practice of electrical contracting until such time as the Board shall authorize his reinstatement; pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$20,000.00 for failing to return his pressure seal issued to Ed Johnson Electric and pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000.00 for continuously advertising, entering into, engaging in and working as an electrical contractor without securing a business permit in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9 and N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.5(e); and pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000.00 for engaging in professional and occupational misconduct in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e). Mr. Johnson is provisionally prohibited from applying for reinstatement until such time as he fully satisfies all penalties and requirements of the Order. Mr. Johnson is provisionally reprimanded for violating and failing to comply with the provisions of an act and regulation administered by the Board in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h) and provisionally reprimanded for engaging in professional and occupational misconduct pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e).
