CALL TO ORDER

Due to the current state of emergency, the March 18, 2021 meeting of the Board of Examiners of Electrical Contractors was not held at 124 Halsey Street, but remotely. The agenda was provided below to the extent known at the time of this notice. The meeting was limited to urgent matters and those related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Any public comments were submitted by 2:00 P.M. on March 17, 2021 by e-mailing Philameana L. Tucker, Executive Director, at tuckerp@dca.njoag.gov. The Board made its best efforts to read any comments received during the meeting.

The Board saluted the Flag.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve (7) Initial Licenses which will expire on March 31, 2024.

Motion made by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve (8) Initial Business Permits which will expire on March 31, 2024.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve (2) of the (3) Initial Business Permits Previously Expired effective March 18, 2021 to March 31, 2024. (#1 is being held in abeyance pending further review).

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve (10) of the (16) Changes in Business Permits effective March 18, 2021 to March 31, 2024. (#9, #10, #12, #14 are being held in abeyance pending further review).

Motion made by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve the Minutes of the 953rd Open Session Business Meeting held January 13, 2021.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve the Minutes of the 954th Open Session Business Meeting held February 10, 2021.

Money Orders in the amount of \$150.00 received from Carlos Mendez, License #12614, as the first and second installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1). The balance due is \$2,700.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$150.00 received from John A. Schipani, License #14228, t/a John A. Schipani Electrical Contractor, as the eighth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9(a). Payments began February 20, 2020 and the balance due is \$650.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$150.00 received from Timothy Boyle, License #12643, as the third installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1). Payments began February 6, 2020 and the balance due is \$2,550.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$150.00 received from Kenneth Gorman, License #13786, as the first installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1). Balance due is \$4,850.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$150.00 received from Albert G. Hoesly, License #13598, as the first installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$4,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1). Balance due is \$3,850.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Checks in the amount of \$150.00 and \$300.00 received from Philip J. DeNivo, License #15902, as the eighth and ninth installments of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1). Payments began March 27, 2020 and the balance due is \$1,350.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$50.00 received from George Isabella, License #14732, t/a George Isabella Electrical Contractor, as the thirty-first installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,500.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3(c) (1). Payments began July 27, 2018 and the balance due is \$850.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$1,495.00 received from John Hartnett, License #15973, as the sixteenth and final payment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$4,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1).

The Board accepted the payment.

The Board reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Bernie Corrigan, IBEW Local 102, requesting approval to teach new courses and previously approved instructors.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. Corrigan requesting that he provide the resumes of the previously approved instructors so that the Board may ensure these individuals are qualified to teach the new courses.

The Board reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Mark Sobhy, Warshaer Electric Supply, requesting approval to teach new courses and new instructors.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed to approve seven (7) new courses and instructors.

Letter dated February 17, 2021, received from Dennis Campbell, Instructor #387, requesting 15 hours of credit towards the renewal of his License #7694 pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7. Mr. Campbell has provided copies of attendance certification sheets reflecting that he has taught 62 hours of continuing education courses which includes the nine hours of code changes and the one hour of laws, rules and regulations.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. Campbell requesting he submit copies of sign-in/sign-out sheets to substantiate he has taught 15 hours of continuing education courses.

E-mail received from Ernest M. Davis, Instructor #1010, requesting 15 hours of credit towards the renewal of his License #6124 pursuant to N.J.A.C. to 13:31-1.7.

On behalf of Mr. Davis, an e-mail was received from Sarah Hagy, Executive Director, The Electrical Association of Philadelphia, providing copies of registration lists in lieu of sign-in sign-out sheets reflecting that Mr. Davis has taught 16 hours of continuing education courses.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to grant Mr. Davis 15 credits towards the renewal of his License #6124.

Anna Bennett, Regulatory Analyst, discussed with the Board the proposed draft under N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7 Continuing Education.

Ms. Bennett stated that the Board requested some revisions in the proposed draft under (d) (5) and (d) (7).

5. Successful completion of a United States Department of Labor, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA)-approved online safety course, notwithstanding the credit amount limitations in (e)1i and (e)1i(1).

7. Successful completion of a program in the installation of natural or manufactured gas piping relevant to installing or repairing electric generators approved by the Board pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7 (h).

Mr. Papademas stated the word “natural” should be deleted.

Mr. Flaherty stated that this language concerns the installation of generators and the manufacture’s wording is “natural gas fuel.

Mr. Flaherty asked if these modifications would take affect with the assumption that the governor’s executive order will expire.

Mr. Schooley answered affirmatively.

Mr. Schooley stated that he is concerned that our licensees will not understand how many hours of continuing education they will be granted under (d) (5) and (d) (6). For example under (d) (5) the Board is allowing up to eight (8) hours of OSHA credit; however, the way the language is written the licensee would have to refer back to (e) 1i and (e) 1i(1). Same for (d) (6), the language does not specify how many hours the licensee can take to receive credited.

Mr. Schooley also stated that Ms. Bennett did a very good job; however, the Board feels very strongly in making this easy for the licensee to understand how many hours of continuing education courses they may attend toward their renewal.

DAG Donofrio it would be easier if the hour limitations would be included as opposed to just making the reference.

Ms. Bennett stated that she will restructure the language in 5 through 7 to reflect the number of credited hours and include those references.

Mr. Flaherty stated that he is still has concerns that the licensee is the one actually taking the on-line continuing education courses. The instructor must still confirm attendance.

DAG Donofrio stated that the regulations already exist and stipulate that sponsors must comply with the requirements of N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7, which includes the monitoring of attendance at each approved course.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, that the proposed drafted language in (d) (5) and (d) (7) be amended to reflect the number of continuing education hours allowed.

Anna Bennett, Regulatory Analyst, discussed with the Board the proposed new language under 13:31-2.3 Qualifications of Applicants which defines the wording “accredited and approved”.

N.J.A.C. 13:31-2.3 Experience requirements:

(a) For purposes of this section, the following words and terms shall have the following meanings, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

“Accredited and approved” means that an apprenticeship program is registered with or approved by the United States Department of Labor.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve the above proposed language defining “accredited and approved” as used in N.J.A.C. 13:31-2.3 (a).

The Board discussed the sunset of the Board’s regulations at N.J.A.C. 13:31-1 et seq. that will expire on March 16, 2022.

Mr. Schooley stated that he and Mr. Flaherty will review the Board’s Rules and Regulations and seek input from the full Board to suggest any changes that should be made at Sunset.

Motion made by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to appoint Mr. Schooley and Mr. Flaherty to review the Board’s rules and regulations and suggest any changes that should be made at Sunset.

Mrs. Tucker stated that she has nothing to report to the Board other than the Board may be able to hold their April meeting via a Zoom platform.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.
