The Board saluted the Flag.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve (8) Initial Licenses which will expire on March 31, 2018. (Licenses were issued from April 11, 2018 to May 10, 2018).

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Joseph F. Cantalupo, and unanimously passed, to approve (10) Initial Business Permits which will expire on March 31, 2018. (Business Permits were issued from April 11, 2018 to May 10, 2018).

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve the Minutes of the 927th Open Session Business Meeting held March 14, 2018.

Payment in the amount of \$1,000.00 received on February 16, 2018, from Edward Johnson, License #7469 (Revoked), as the sixteenth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$30,000.00 for violation of $\underline{\text{N.J.S.A}}$. 45:5A-9; $\underline{\text{N.J.A.C}}$. 13:31-1.5(e); and $\underline{\text{N.J.S.A}}$. 45:1-21(e). Payments started on June 1, 2017 and the balance due is \$7,000.00.

The Board reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from John A. Delesandro, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs/Rutgers University, requesting approval of new courses and instructors.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. Delesandro requesting that he resubmit his application as the resumes provided are not reflected on the continuing education application.

The Board reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Rose Boyd, e-Hazard Management, LLC, requesting approval of new courses and instructors.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve five (5) new courses and instructors. Ms. Boyd will be reminded that licensees must take all forty (40) hours of the course entitled "NEC For Industrial Installations" in order to receive a certificate of completion.

The Board asked Mrs. Tucker to contact PSI and advise them that the electrical contractor's examination should contain questions from all reference material listed in their Candidate Bulletin, including the NFPA 72 National Fire Alarm Code book.

The Board reviewed applications for the licensing examination to be administered by PSI Services, LLC. Eighteen (18) applications were approved.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. James H. Flaherty, and unanimously passed, to go into Executive Closed Session to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.
