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Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve the Minutes of the  $974^{\rm th}$  Open Session Business Meeting held January 11, 2023.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve the Minutes of the 975<sup>th</sup> Open Session Business Meeting held February 8, 2023.

The Minutes of the  $976^{\rm th}$  Open Session Business Meeting held March 15, 2023, were not ready for review.

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Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve (15) Initial Licenses which will expire on March 31, 2024.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve (12) Initial Business Permits which will expire on March 31, 2024.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve (1) of the (3) Initial Business Permits Previously Expired effective April 12, 2023 to March 31, 2024. (#1 is held in abeyance pending further review).

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve (8) of the (13) Changes in Business Permits effective April 12, 2023 to March 31, 2024. (#3, #6, #7, #9, and #11 are being held in abeyance pending further review).

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Check in the amount of \$150.00 received from Raymond P. Gearhart, License #16403, t/a R P Gearhart Jr., Electrical Contractor, LLC, as the second installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,000.00 for violation of 8.3.4. 13:31-3.3 (c)(1). Payments started March 3, 2023 and the balance due is \$2,700.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

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Check in the amount of \$150.00 each received from Todd Ciamei, License #16604, as the fourth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c)(1). Payments started May 13, 2022 and the balance due is \$1,400.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$150.00 received from Christopher Meyers, License #13140, t/a Christopher Meyers Electrical Services, as the thirtieth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$6,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c)(1). Payments started October 14, 2020 and the balance due is \$1,500.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

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Check in the amount of \$200.00 received from Monica E. Merel, License #15260, t/a Clean Energy Electric & Solar, LLC, as the tenth and final payment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1).

The Board accepted the payment.

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Check in the amount of \$300.00 received from William K. Graetz, License #14135, as the fourth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000.00 for violation of  $\underline{\text{N.J.A.C}}$ . 13:31-3.3 (c)(1). The balance due is \$1,000.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

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Check in the amount of \$200.00 received from Robert K. Bryant, License #15293, t/a Bryant Construction & Electrical Contracting, LLC, as the sixth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000.00 for violation of  $\underline{\text{N.J.A.C}}$ . 13:31-3.3 (c)(1). Payments started November 2, 2022 and the balance due is \$800.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

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Check in the amount of \$150.00 received from Steven T. Scotti, License #16987, t/a Trulite Electric, LLC, as the thirteenth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c)(1). Payments started April 22, 2022 and the balance due is \$1,050.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

 $\operatorname{Mr.}$  James H. Flaherty is recused from the following discussion and motion.

The Board reviewed an Application to Reinstate Expired Electrical Contractors License #15080 received from Nicholas Mangelli, Jr.

Office files reflect that Mr. Mangelli's License and Business Permit #15080 expired on March 31, 2015.

Office files also reflect Mr. Mangelli signed an acknowledgement on March 20, 2023, agreeing to pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$10,000.00 for violation of 8.3.2. 13:31-3.5 and 8.3.2. 13:31.1.2 and N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1).

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to reinstate Mr. Mangelli's License #15080 as he has demonstrated to the Board's satisfaction that he meets the requirement for reinstatement.

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The Board reviewed an Application to Reactivate Inactive Electrical Contractors License #14452 received from William J. Wojtowicz.

Office files reflect that Mr. Wojtowicz placed License #14452 in inactive status on April 12, 2021.

Office files also reflect that the business permit was closed on May 13, 2020.

Office files further reflect the two previously issued pressure seal were returned on a timely basis.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, that this matter be discussed in Executive Session.

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The Board reviewed an Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Meghan Holt, Mike Holt Enterprises, requesting approval to teach five (5) new courses.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. Holt advising him that his request is denied as it does not appear the courses will be taught as live interactive courses. Mr. Holt will be advised that he may submit a new application which reflects that he will teach live interactive courses as indicated in N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7.

The Board reviewed an Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Dana Villari, Warshauer Electric Supply, requesting approval of one new instructor to teach a previously approved course.

As per the Board's request, Ms. Villari provided a more detailed resume for Mr. Conway.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve one new instructor to teach a previously approved course.

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The Board reviewed an Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Charise Wilson, New Jersey Independent Electrical Contractors, Inc., requesting approval of one new course and instructor.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve one new course and instructor.

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Letter dated January 8, 2023, received from Joseph Pomerantz, License #13534, t/a Pomerantz Electric, Inc., requesting a waiver of the ten hour code and law portion of his Continuing Education Courses pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:5A-13.4.

Office files reflect that Mr. Pomerantz has a current license and business permit.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. Pomerantz advising him that the Board will allow him to take the course "on-line" as long as the instructor teaches the course via a Zoom platform.

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Anthony Menafro, Construction Code Specialist, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, appeared before the Board concerning the acceptance of licensees to submit electronically verified applications.

Mr. Menafro stated he was concerned the Board opposed the idea of electronically verified applications.

Mr. Schooley stated the Board did oppose the Bill, but has not discussed this matter since it was last on the Agenda four or five years ago.

Mr. Menafro stated that most municipalities are prepared to accept electronic verification; however, letters of attestation are still accepted. Mr. Menafro also stated after the permit is electronically verified, the licensee must still down load and sign and seal the application. Mr. Menafro stated after the paperwork is submitted, the municipality can then send that person a comment about any problems that may exist with the paperwork; by the end of the day the problem can be corrected. The site allows continuous accessibility.

Mr. Menafro stated that the Board of Engineers was the first to accept the electronic verification.

Mr. Flaherty stated the Board has a responsibility for the consumer and there are many problems unlicensed practice.

Mr. Menafro stated this will not stop unlicensed practice and we will not be able to determine who is qualified.

Mr. Papademas asked why Mr. Menafro was asking the Board to allow electronic verification when permits are regulated by Community Affairs.

Mr. Menafro stated he is only trying to make the Board aware that this is happening.

Mr. Schooley asked how a homeowner would obtain an electrical permit.

Mr. Menafro stated for now a homeowner would fill out the physical permit application.

Mr. Menafro stated he is happy to work with the Board and will assist in any way he can.

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Mrs. Tucker stated that she has nothing to report.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.
