The Board saluted the Flag.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve (5) Initial Licenses which will

expire on March 31, 2021.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve (6) Initial Business Permits which will expire on March 31, 2021.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve (8) Initial Business Permits Previously Expired effective May 8, 2019 to March 31, 2021.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve (6) Changes in Business Permits effective May 8, 2019 to March 31, 2021.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve the Minutes of the 938th Open Session Business Meeting held March 13, 2019.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve the Minutes of the 939th Open Session Business Meeting held April 10, 2019.

Check in the amount of \$200.00 received from Dennis Arcamone, License #13834, as the second installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1). Payments started March 15, 2019 and the balance due is \$2,600.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$167.00 received from John Hartnett, License #15973, as the fifth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$4,000.00 for violation of $\underline{\text{N.J.A.C}}$. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1). Payments began November 27, 2018 and the balance due is \$3,165.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$50.00 received from George Isabella, License #14732, t/a George Isabella Electrical Contractor, as the ninth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,500.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1). Payments began July 27, 2018 and the balance due is \$1,900.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$167.00 received from Barry J. Yeslow, License #9340, as the eleventh installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000.00 for violation of $\underline{\text{N.J.A.C.}}$ 13:31-3.3 (c) (1). Payments started July 11, 2018 and the balance due is \$163.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$250.00 received from Anthony Vignali, License #14343 (Suspended), as the first installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$10,000.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$8,000.00 received from Jaime Abramo, License #11917, (Inactive), as the first and final payment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$8,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1).

The Board accepted the payment.

Application to Reactivate an Inactive Electrical Contractors License received from Richard Neely, License #13654, (Inactive).

Office files reflect Mr. Neely chose Inactive status for his License #13654 on March 10, 2015 and Business Permit #13654 on March 31, 2003.

Pressure seal issued to Richard Neely Electrical Contractor returned to the Board office on February 11, 2019.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, that this matter be discussed in Executive Closed Session.

The Board reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Steven J. Owen, National Code Seminars, requesting approval of new courses.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve four (4) new courses and the instructor.

The Board reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Anthony Fontes, National Fire Protection Association, requesting approval of new courses and instructors.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve two (2) new courses and instructors. Mr. Fontes' request to teach on-line courses is being held in abeyance. Mr. Fontes will be asked to explain how he intends to verify attendance and whether or not the on-line training courses are instructor led.

Rachel Glasgow, Regulatory Analyst, discussed with the Board on-line continuing education courses.

Mrs. Glasgow stated most of the Boards that allow on-line continuing education do not recommend the software that is to be used by the instructor. Mrs. Glasgow also stated the Board can require that the sponsor ensure attendance, offer interactive courses, and limit the number of on-line credits.

Mr. Flaherty stated he feels sponsors should utilize a software program that has facial recognition and will restart the course should the licensee walk away from the computer.

Mrs. Glasgow stated she will research the other Board's regulations concerning continuing education.

Mr. Schooley stated that the nine hours of code changes and the one hour of laws, rules, and regulations should not be an on-line course and should be taught in a class room environment.

Mr. Flaherty stated that there are certain training courses, such as OSHA courses, that are only available on-line.

Mrs. Glasgow stated that the comment period regarding the Pre-proposal concerning Power over the Ethernet ended on January 4, 2019. However, even though we generally accept late filed comments, the Board has received approximately forty to fifty additional comments. Many of these very late comments are of a similar template letter. Mrs. Glasgow also stated that these recent comments have been referred to the Committee.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, that as of this date, no further comments will be accepted by the Board.

Mrs. Glasgow advised the Board that Assembly Bill A-2810 concerning state supervision was passed on February 21, 2019; however the governor has not enacted the bill into law.

Mrs. Tucker stated that a letter dated April 16, 2019, was received from an applicant who recently failed the business and law portion of the examination by one point. The applicant is requesting that the Board consider a similar examination he passed in the State of Connecticut which was also conducted by PSI.

The Board directed that a letter be sent to the applicant informing him the Board does not have reciprocity and because laws are different in each state, he must take and pass the business and law portion of the examination.

The Board reviewed applications for the licensing examination to be administered by PSI Services, LLC. Six (6) applications were approved.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law,

including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.

Meeting adjourned at 3:00 P.M.
