The Board saluted the Flag.

The Minutes of the 967 Open Session Business Meeting held May 11, 2021, were not yet ready for approval.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve (19) Initial Licenses which will expire on March 31, 2024.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve (14) Initial Business Permits which will expire on March 31, 2024.

The Initial Business Permits Previously Expired list and the Change in Business Permits list will be discussed in Executive Closed Session.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve (3) Initial Business Permits Previously Expired effective June 8, 2022 to March 31, 2024. (#1, #3 and #5 are being held in abeyance pending further review).

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve (4) Changes in Business Permits effective June 8, 2022 to March 31, 2024.

Check in the amount of \$150.00 received from Joseph F. Kiss, License #15304, t/a L B Electric Inc., as the tenth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1). Payments started June 17, 2021 and the balance due is \$3,500.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

The Board reviewed an Application to Reinstate an Expired Electrical Contractors License received from Christian F. Rupp, IV, License #8149.

Office files reflect that Mr. Rupp's License and Business Permit #8149 expired on March 31, 2021.

Office files also reflect that the pressure seal issued to C R Electrical Contracting was not returned to the Board office.

Motion made by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone and seconded by Mr. James H. Flaherty, and unanimously passed, that this matter be discussed in Executive Closed Session.

The Board reviewed an Application to Reinstate an Expired Electrical Contractors License received from Steven Keares, License #12491.

Office files reflect that Mr. Keares' License and Business Permit #12491 expired on March 31, 2021. Office files also reflect that Mr. Keares paid for his business permit renewal on January 12, 2021, but did not pay for his license renewal.

Office files also reflect that the pressure seal issued to Steven Keares, Inc. was not returned to the Board office.

Motion made by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone and seconded by Mr. James H. Flaherty, and unanimously passed, to reinstate Mr. Keares' License #12494 as he has demonstrated to the Board's satisfaction that he meets the requirement for reinstatement.

The Board reviewed an Application to Reinstate an Expired Electrical Contractors License received from Ricardo Rondon, License #15053.

Office files reflect that Mr. Rondon's License and Business Permit #15053 expired on March 31, 2021.

Office files also reflect that the pressure seal issued to Ricardo Rondon Electrical Contractor was not returned to the Board office.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, that this matter be discussed in Executive Closed Session.

The Board reviewed an Application to Reinstate an Expired Qualified Journeyman Electricians Registration received from Christopher R. Rees, Qualified Journeyman #1108.

Office files reflect that Mr. Rees' Qualified Journeyman Registration #1108 expired on December 31, 2018.

Motion made by Mr. James L. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to reinstate Mr. Rees' Qualified Journeyman Electricians Registration #1108 as he has demonstrated to the Board's satisfaction that he meets the requirement for reinstatement.

The Board reviewed an Application to Reactivate an Inactive Electrical Contractors License received from Stanislav Ageyev, License #17980.

Office files reflect that Mr. Ageyev chose inactive status for his License and Business Permit #17980 on April 17, 2018.

Office files also reflect that the pressure seal issued to EFS Electrical Services, Inc. was returned to the Board office on April 28, 2021.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, that this matter be discussed in Executive Closed Session.

The Board reviewed an Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Carey Walker, IEC Chesapeake Apprenticeship & Training, Inc., requesting approval to teach new courses and previously approved instructors.

Motion made by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone and seconded by Mr. James H. Flaherty, and unanimously passed, to approve four (4) new courses and three (3) previously approved instructors.

Mrs. Tucker stated that she received an e-mail from Thomas C. Pitcherello, Code Specialist, Department of Community Affairs, Division of Code and Standards, asking if an HVACR contractor or plumbing contractor is allowed to remove and replace an existing boiler or furnace, which would include the disconnection and reconnection of the existing electrical work, and the replacement of the duplex outlets and switch, pursuant to $\underline{\text{N.J.S.A.}}$. 45:5A-18 (m).

Mr. Flaherty stated that the Board should meet with the regulatory analyst to assist in drafting regulations. Mr. Flaherty also stated that the current exemption seems to allow the individual to perform the electrical work; however, the HVACR exemption supersedes N.J.S.A. 45:5A-18(m).

Mrs. Tucker stated that the new Pool and Spa Committee will hold its first meeting on June 20, 2022.

Motion made by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone and seconded by Mr. James H. Flaherty, and unanimously passed, to go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.
