Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve the Minutes of the $977^{\rm th}$ Open Session Business Meeting held April 12, 2023.

Motion made by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve (21) Initial Licenses which will expire on March 31, 2024.

Motion made by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve (13) Initial Business Permits which will expire on March 31, 2024.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve (6) of the (8) Initial Business Permits Previously Issued effective June 14, 2023 to March 31, 2024. ($\sharp 1$ & $\sharp 3$ are held in abeyance pending further review).

Check in the amount of \$600.00 received from Brad T. Kleinman, License \$17747, t/a Electric Doctor, LLC, as the third installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,000.00 for violation of \$N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3(c)(1). Payments began January 18, 2023 and the balance due is \$1,800.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Cardillo, License #15000, t/a Power Tech Electrical Contracting, LLC, as the seventh installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$4,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3(c)(1). Payments started August 19, 2022 and the balance due is \$1,500.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$3,500.00 received from Tadeusz Sadej, License \$13680, t/a T S Electrical Contractor, as the first and final payment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,500.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13-31-3.3(c)(1).

The Board accepted the payment.

Two checks in the amount of \$200.00 each received from Anthony W. Silva, License #16837, t/a AMK Electrical LLC, as the first and second installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,000.00 for violation of $\underline{\text{N.J.A.C}}$. 13-31-3.3(c)(1). The balance due is \$2,600.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$400.00 received from Ricardo Rondon, License \$15053, t/a Ricardo Rondon Electrical Contractor, as ninth and final payment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3(c)(1).

The Board accepted the payment.

Cashier's Check in the amount of \$300.00 received from Kevin R. yle, License #16297, t/a Lyle Electric, as the twelfth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$4,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3(c)(1). Payments started December 2, 2021 and the balance due is \$1,600.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Cashier's check in the amount of \$4,000.00 received from Freddy R. Izquierdo, License \$8462, t/a Santana Electric, as the first and final payment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$4,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.2.

The Board accepted the payment.

The Board reviewed an Application to Reinstate Expired Electrical Contractors License #8155 received from Shawn P. Gianella.

Office files reflect that Mr. Gianella's License #8155 expired on March 31, 2009.

Office files also reflect that Mr. Gianella withdrew his Business Permit #8155 and returned the pressure seal issued to Solutions Repair & Electrical Company on February 23, 2007.

Motion made by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to reinstate Mr. Gianella's License #8155 as he has demonstrated to the Board's satisfaction that he meets the requirement for reinstatement. Mr. Gianella will be advised that he must again take thirty four hours of continuing education courses to renew his License #8155 for the 2024 triennial renewal period.

The Board reviewed an Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Joseph Wages, Jr., International Association of Electrical Inspectors-International Office (IAEI-IO), requesting approval to teach four (4) new courses and a new instructor.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve four (4) new courses and one instructor.

Letter dated May 11, 2023, received from Ed Sofield, Sponsor #40, asking if credit is given to licensed electrical contractors, who are not contractors, for completing the nine hours of code changes and the one hour of laws, rules, and regulations.

Additionally, Mr. Sofield stated that the wording in the regulations for continuing education requirements should be changed. Mr. Sofield also stated that the current wording reads "the most recent edition of the National Electrical Code". However, the 2020 NEC was adopted on September 6, 2020 and the 2023 NEC has not yet been adopted.

Mr. Sofield further stated that the language should read "the most recent edition of the National Electrical Code that is adopted by New Jersey".

Mr. Papademas stated that licensees are required to attend the most recent published edition of the National Electrical Code. At this time the most recent published edition is the NFPA 70 2023 code.

Mrs. Tucker stated that she has nothing to report to the Board.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.
