Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, this matter be discussed in Executive Closed Session.

The Board reviewed an Application to Reactivate an Inactive Electrical Contractors License received from Ernest Hammesfahr, License #7726.

Office files reflect that License #7726 was placed in inactive status on February 24, 2021, and Business Permit #7726 was placed in inactive status on May 03, 2015.

Office files reflect that the pressure seal issued to Main Electric Co Inc was returned October 13, 2015.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve this matter for reactivation.

The Board reviewed an Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar received from Kristen Kassem, Director of Licensing and Compliance, Elite CEU, Inc., requesting approval for one (1) new instructor to teach thirty-nine (39) new courses.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to hold this matter in abeyance pending resubmission with the required revisions.

Motion made by Anthony L. Anzelone and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve the three (3) previous instructors and nine (9) new instructors to teach one (1) new course.

The Board reviewed an Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar received from Neil D. Nagy, Father Time Seminars, requesting approval for one (1) previous approved instructor and one (1) new instructor to teach one (1) new course.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve one (1) previous approved instructor and one (1) new instructor to teach one (1) new course.

Charles Manning, Regulatory Analyst, Division of Consumer Affairs appeared before the Board to discuss the comments he received from the New Licensing Rule.

The Executive Director Ms. Tucker stated that any correspondence related to the Board must be address to the Board and not to the individual members of the Board.

The Chairman of the Board Mr. Flaherty reiterated the same.
