952nd BUSINESS MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EXAMINERS OF ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS (PUBLIC SESSION) - - - NOVEMBER 18, 2020

CALL TO ORDER

Due to the current state of emergency, the November 18, 2020 meeting of the Board of Examiners of Electrical Contractors was not held at 124 Halsey Street, but remotely. The Board saluted the Flag.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve (6) Initial Licenses which will expire on March 31, 2021.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve (6) of the (7) Initial Business Permits which will expire on March 31, 2021. (#2 is being held in abeyance pending further review).

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve (1) of the (4) Initial Business Permits Previously Expired effective November 18, 2020 to March 31, 2021. (#2, #3 and #4 are being held in abeyance pending further review).

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, to approve (2) of the (6) Changes in Business Permits effective November 18, 2020 to March 31, 2021. (#4 and #5 are being held in abeyance pending further review).

Check in the amount of \$454.43 received from Michael D. Carr, License #13643, as the twelfth and final installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,000.00 for violation of \$N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1).

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$450.00 and two checks in the amount of \$150.00 each received from James L. Morecraft, License #16513, t/a James Morecraft Electrical Contractor, as the fourth, fifth, and sixth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3(c) (1). Payments started October 29, 2019 and the balance due is \$1,100.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$250.00 from Dean A. Pesarini, License #11825, as the fifth and final installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1).

The Board accepted the payment.

The Board reviewed an Application to Reinstate an Expired Electrical Contractors License received from Javier Marte, License #17043 (Expired).

Office files reflect Mr. Marte's License and Business Permit #17403 expired on March 31, 2018.

Office files also reflect that the pressure seal issued to Industrial Automation Control, LLC has not been returned to the Board office.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, that this matter be discussed in Closed Session.

The Board reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Yehudit Gelb, School of Electrical Education, requesting approval to teach new courses and instructors.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, that the course entitled "New York City 8 Hr License Renewal Class" is not approved as it does not meet the requirements of continuing education pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7. The course entitled "Cash Flow and Job Progress Control" is approved along with the instructor.

The Board reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Colleen McLaughlin, RAB Lighting, requesting approval to teach a new course and instructors.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve one (1) new course and instructors.

The Board reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Meghan Holt, Mike Holt Enterprises, requesting approval to teach new courses and an instructor.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, that the Board is amending its previous motion as the courses were inadvertently approved at the September 2020 meeting. Ms. Holt will be requested to explain how she is monitoring these courses and the licensee's attendance. Ms. Holt will also be advised that a test/quiz cannot be part of the instructional hours nor does the licensee need a passing score in order to receive a certificate.

Additionally, the following motion was made so that the Board can discuss continuing education with the regulatory analyst.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, that the Board meet with the regulatory analyst to discuss modifying the continuing education requirements to reflect live presentations.

The Board reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Jason Minard, Sonos, requesting approval to teach a new course and instructors. The FBL Committee referred the application to the Board for review.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve one (1) new course and an instructor.

The Board reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar approval received from Anna Keating, United Inspection Agency, requesting approval to teach new courses and an instructor.

Motion made by Mr. Constantinos Papademas and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to approve three (3) new courses and instructors. Ms. Keating will be advised that licensees must complete all hours in order to receive a certificate for courses #2 and #3.

The Board reviewed an e-mail received from Ed Allmann, Electrical Subcode Official, Township of Livingston, asking whether or not a certificate or identification card will be issued to those contractors that have attended a continuing education course in the installation of gas piping for a generator.

Mr. Schooley stated that the Board should propose a regulation that would make sure a licensee gets a certificate for taking a gas piping course.

Mr. Papademas stated upon purchasing the piping, the supply house requires that the purchaser possess a certificate specifying that individual has taken a course for gas piping installation. The supply houses usually offer those courses and the individual is given a card after completing the course and passing the examination.

Motion made by Mr. Gino Pasqualone and seconded by Mr. Anthony L. Anzelone, and unanimously passed, that the Board meet with the regulatory analyst to discuss proposing a new regulation for certification for the installation of gas piping.

The Board requested that a letter be sent to Mr. Allmann advising him that the Board is in the process of proposing a new regulation to require that a certificate be issued after completion of a gas piping course.

E-mail dated September 8, 2020, received from Todd J. Ciamei, License #16604, (Inactive), in response to the Settlement Letter offering him the opportunity to settle the matter by paying a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1).

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, that a letter to Mr. Ciamei advising him that the Board reaffirms its decision to offer him the opportunity to settle this matter by paying a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-3.3 (c) (1).

The Board voted to cancel the meeting which was scheduled for December 9, 2020. The Board gives Joseph P. Schooley executive authority to carry out any decisions in the absence of the meeting.

Mrs. Tucker also stated that she received no comments from the public.

Motion made by Mr. James Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Gino Pasqualone, and unanimously passed, to go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.

Meeting adjourned at 2:00 P.M.
