Letter dated January 29, 2003, received from Robert A. Sauer requesting reinstatement of his license #11044 which he failed to renew for the 1994 to 1997; 1997 to 2000; and 2000 to 2003 triennial renewal periods.

Mr. Sauer stated that in 1992 he moved and sent in his change of address by certified mail. However, he never received a renewal and never realized it until he requested business permit paperwork from the Board.

Mr. Sauer has provided copies of his 1993, 1996, and 1999 Continuing Education Code Course Certificates.

Motion made by Mrs. Pushpavati Amin and seconded by Mrs. Connie Calisti, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. Sauer advising him that he must take and pass the electrical contractor's examination in order to regain his license under N.J.S.A. 45:5A-13.

Letter dated November 12, 2002, received from Raymond P. Brandefine requesting reinstatement of his license #6898 which he failed to renew for the 1997 to 2000 and 2000 to 2003 triennial renewal periods.

Mr. Brandefine stated that he did not renew his license due to chronic back problems which required surgery. Mr. Brandefine also stated that he has worked for Con Edison for thirty years in the facilities electrical installations group.

At its December 2002 meeting, the Board denied Mr. Brandefine's request. In response to the Board's request for additional information, a letter dated February 3, 2003, was received from Mr. Brandefine stating that he is still employed by Con Edison and has been for thirty years supervising the electrical installations group.

Mr. Brandefine has also provided a notarized letter stating that his pressure seal remains in the possession of his ex-wife.

Motion made by Mrs. Pushpavati Amin and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. Brandefine advising him that in order to regain his license #6898, he must attend a total of 30 hours of 2002 code refresher courses which is to include one hour of business and law. Mr. Brandefine has six months in which to attend the code refresher courses. The Board would also like Mr. Brandefine to provide a note from his doctor. Mr. Brandefine will also be advised that should he not wish to attend 30 hours of courses, may take and pass the electrical contractor's examination in order to regain his license under N.J.S.A. 45:5A-13.

Letter dated January 8, 2003, received from Kenneth W. Krug requesting approval to teach the Nine Hours of Code Changes and the One Hour of Laws, Rules and Regulations pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:5A-13.3.

Motion made by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec and seconded by Mrs. Pushpavati Amin, and unanimously passed, to approve Mr. Krug to teach the Nine Hours of Code Changes and the One Hour of Laws, Rules and Regulations.

A signed cease and desist agreement was received from William Graham, Broadway, New Jersey 08802.

The Board accepted the signed cease and desist agreement.

The Board discussed the "inactive" license status pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:31-2.4. The law stipulates that a licensee may resume the practice of electrical contracting upon submission of evidence to the Board of having completed the continuing education requirements set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7. The Board discussed how many hours of continuing education the licensee should take when going from "inactive" to "active" status. The Board further discussed the possibility charging a fee to go back into "active" status.

Mr. Schooley stated that at the time a licensee wishes to go from "inactive" status to "active" status, the licensee must write a letter to the Board and provide proof of having completed the continuing education courses required for that renewal cycle. Mr. Schooley also stated that perhaps a reactivation fee can be charged; however, since the Board does not determine fees this will be decided by the Division at a later date.

Letter dated February 21, 2003, received from Charles W. Auge, License #11243, requesting a six-month continuance of business under permit #13726. The licensee, Charles S. Auge, died February 20, 2003.

Charles W. Auge has been sent the business permit paperwork so that he may endorse his license #11243 to Auge Electric Co., Inc.

Motion made by Mrs. Gail Best and seconded by Mrs. Pushpavati Amin, and unanimously passed, that a letter be sent to Mr. Auge advising him that the Board has granted the firm of Auge Electric Co., Inc. a six-month

continuance of business permit #13726 according to N.J.S.A. 45:5A-14.

The Board reviewed applications for the written examination to be administered by Experior Assessments, LLC. Thirteen (13) applications were approved.
