The sub-committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from John M. DeBouter, IBEW, Local Union #164.

Motion made by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve one (1) new course and instructor, and previously approved courses and instructors.

Signed cease and desist agreement received from Jules Szklarski, Unlicensed, Bayonne, New Jersey and Inna Vinin, Euroline Furniture, Inc., West Orange, New Jersey.

Richard Sevy appeared before the Board concerning his request to take the electrical contractor's examination. Mr. Sevy stated that he was advised that the Canadian Code is not the same as the National Electrical Code.

Mr. Malec stated that there are a lot of similarities; however, there are differences in the Code.

DAG Donofrio stated that the regulations of the Board state that an applicant for examination must have done work under the National Electrical Code.

Motion made by Mr. Joseph F. Cantalupo and seconded by Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, to go into Executive Closed Session to receive advice of counsel.

The Board returned to Open Session.

Mr. Malec advised Mr. Sevy that the Board is in a dilemma as to whether the Canadian Code is similar to the National Electrical Code.

Mr. Sevy stated that he can get letters from inspectors to say that he has performed work under the National Electrical Code. Mr. Sevy also stated that if the Board allows him to take the electrical contractor's examination, he will take a course on the National Electrical Code to ensure his understanding of same. Mr. Sevy further stated that he is licensed in Canada as an electrical contractor. Mr. Sevy stated that the standards in Canada are very high and in order to sit for the examination an individual must have 9,000 hours of apprenticeship training and vocational schooling. Mr. Sevy also stated that the examination is based on practical, theory, and the code.

Mr. Schooley advised Mr. Sevy that the Board will continue its review of his application and he will receive the Board's decision in writing.

\*\*\*\*\*\*

Maryann Sheehan, Regulatory Analyst, Director's Office, appeared before the Board at 10:15 A.M.

Mrs. Sheehan stated that Governor Christie has issued Executive Order #2 to determine if any rules and regulations are inconsistent with Federal Law and if any are unduly burdensome which would cause individuals not to come into New Jersey to work.

Mrs. Sheehan also stated that she met with Marian Fiore and DAG Donofrio to discuss this matter. Mrs. Sheehan further stated that she will recommend that sponsors who are not making any changes in their course description should not have to pay the continuing education fee until a change is made.

Mrs. Sheehan also stated that another recommendation would be to allow licensees to take a portion of their credits on-line as long as there are mechanisms in place to ensure that the licensee is taking the course.

Mrs. Sheehan further stated that she will also recommend changing the reinstatement rule which requires a licensee to retake the electrical contractor's examination if the licensee has not renewed within a five year period.

Mrs. Sheehan asked the Board whether or not the rule which requires supervision for every ten employees is burdensome.

Mr. Schooley stated that the rule is not burdensome and is critical for public safety.

Mrs. Sheehan stated that she will prepare a report based on these recommendations.

The Board reviewed applications for the written examination to be administered by Thomson Prometric. Eighty-one (81) applications were approved.

Motion made by Mr. Richard T. Aicher, Jr. and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, that the Board go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.
