Board meeting of June 1, 2011, was called to order at 9:00 A.M. The following members were present:

Joseph Donofrio, Deputy Attorney General, Division of Law, was present from 9:00 A.M. until the close of the meeting.

Also in attendance was John Dubyna, Electrical Contractors Association of New Jersey.

The Board saluted the Flag.

Motion made by Mr. James H. Flaherty and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve six (6) Initial Licenses effective June 1, 2011 to March 31, 2012.

Motion made by Mr. Joseph F. Cantalupo and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve thirteen (13) Initial Business Permits effective June 1, 2011 to March 31, 2012.

Motion made by Mr. Joseph F. Cantalupo and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve two (2) Initial Business Permits Previously Expired effective June 1, 2011 to March 31, 2012.

Motion made by Mr. Joseph F. Cantalupo and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve six (6) Changes in Business Permits effective June 1, 2011 to March 31, 2012.

Postal Money Order in the amount of \$100.00 received from William Passione, License #11485, t/a B. Passione Electric, as the fifteenth installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$3,500.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9, N.J.S.A. 56:8-1 et seq., and N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.2. Payments started February 4, 2010 and the balance due is \$1,995.00.

The Board accepted the payment.

Check in the amount of \$200.00 received from Kenneth J. Ryan, License #7284, t/a Abacus Electric Company, as the first and final payment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$200.00 for violation of N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.5(b) and N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.2.

The Board accepted the payment.

The sub-committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Anthony G. Nicolosi, Jr.

Motion made by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve ten (10) new courses and instructors.

The sub-committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Michele Powell, New Jersey Electrical Contractors Association.

Motion made by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve seventeen (17) new courses and instructors.

The sub-committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Rick Paese, Tegg Corporation.

Motion made by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve two (2) new courses and instructors.

The sub-committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Richard Bernhardt, John-Winston Engineers & Consultants, Inc.

Motion made by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve four (4) new courses and instructors. Mr. Bernhardt will be advised that the courses are approved as five hour courses as the Board does not allow an examination to be part of the instructional hours.

The sub-committee reviewed additional information received from Andrew Zimdahl, Executive Director, Infinite Solar, Inc. The Board held in abeyance the request to teach Continuing Education Courses pending receipt of a more detailed breakdown and description of the courses entitled "Solar PV Design & Installation" and "Solar Thermal Design & Installation".

Motion made by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve one (1) new course and instructor. Mr. Zimdahl will be advised that the Board is only approving twenty (20) hours of the forty (40) hour course. Licensed electrical contractors must attend all 40 hours in order to receive a certificate for the renewal of their license. It is the Board's recommendation that Mr. Zimdahl include this language in his advertisements.

The courses entitled "Solar Thermal Design & Installation" and "Solar Sales Workshop" are not approved as they do not meet the criteria of continuing education pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:31-1.7.

The sub-committee reviewed additional information received from Scott W. Kortvely. The Board held in abeyance the request to teach Continuing Education Courses pending receipt of the subject matter; how the courses will be conducted; and the number of days the courses will be taught for the courses entitled "Continuing Ed. Units-Trade Related - 24 hrs" and "Continuing Ed. Units - Trade Related - 60hrs".

Motion made by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec and seconded by Mr. Constantinos Papademas, and unanimously passed, to approve two (2) new courses and instructor.

Mr. Papademas recused himself from the following discussion and motion.

The sub-committee reviewed an application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Constantinos Papademas.

Motion made by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec and seconded by Mr. Joseph F. Cantalupo, and passed, to approve four (4) new courses and instructor and previously approved courses.

The Board discussed the possibility of allowing licensees to take on-line continuing education courses.

Mr. Papademas stated that Mr. Delassandro sent him a sample on-line course entitled Barrier Free. Mr. Papademas also stated that the computer calculates the amount of time the student is in attendance to ensure that the student is logged on. The students can push a button and ask a question which the instructor will answer.

Mr. Papademas also stated that he will take the full on-line course shortly.

Mr. Flaherty stated that when he attends a seminar, he is asked for picture identification; how does the sponsor/instructor know that the person on the other end of the computer is actually the licensee taking the course.

Mr. Malec stated that the training is for the benefit of the licensee. It will be the electrical contractor's loss if he is not taking the course.

Mr. Malec also stated that the instructor does ask questions and if the licensee does not respond, a light will come on alerting the instructor.

This matter is being held in abeyance pending a report from Mr. Papademas.

The Board reviewed applications for the written examination to be administered by Prometric. Twenty-two (22) applications were approved.

Motion made by Mr. Joseph F. Cantalupo and seconded by Mr. Mitchell R. Malec, and unanimously passed, to go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.
