Committee meeting of November 2, 2011, was called to order at 9:00 A.M. The following members were present:

Kathleen Moran, Administrative Assistant 3, was present from 9:00 A.M. until the close of the meeting.

Joseph Donofrio, Deputy Attorney General, Division of Law, was present from 9:00 A.M. until the close of the meeting.

Note: A quorum was not present. All actions are to be ratified at the Board's next meeting to be held on December 7, 2011, or soon thereafter.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve the Minutes of the 859th Open Session Business Meeting held October 5, 2011.

November 2, 2011

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve six (6) Initial Licenses effective November 2, 2011 to March 31, 2012.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve four (4) Initial Business Permits effective November 2, 2011 to March 31, 2012.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve three (3) Initial Business Permits Previously Expired effective November 2, 2011 to March 31, 2012.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve three (3) Changes in Business Permits effective November 2, 2011 to March 31, 2012.

Check in the amount of \$25.00 received from Frank D'Arpa, License #8778 (Inactive), as the fifty-seventh installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,500.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9 and N.J.S.A. 56:8-1 et seq. Payments started September 25, 2002 and the balance due is \$1,075.00.

The Committee accepted the payment.

Postal Money Order in the amount of \$100.00 received from Anthony J. Catalano, Jr., License #7623, as the first installment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$500.00 for violation of N.J.S.A. 45:5A-9. The balance due is \$400.00.

The Committee accepted the payment.

Letter dated October 10, 2011, received from Frank P. Diaco, Secretary, Power Electric Co. Inc., requesting a six-month continuance of business under Permit #1496 according to N.J.S.A. 45:5A-14. The licensee, Joseph Diaco, died on October 1, 2011.

Frank Diaco stated that Theodore F. Diaco, License #9864, will supervise the work being performed and will submit an Initial Business Permit application shortly.

The Committee unanimously recommended that a letter be sent to Frank P. Diaco advising him that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:5A-14 the firm of Power Electric Co. Inc. has been granted a six-month continuance of business under permit #1496. The Board approves Theodore F. Diaco, License #9864, to qualify the business for the six-month period.

November 2, 2011

Additional information received from John M. DeBouter, Local Union #163, IBEW, regarding his request to teach Continuing Education Courses. At its September 7, 2011 meeting, the Board requested that Mr. DeBouter provide a more detailed description/outline of the courses to be taught.

The Committee unanimously recommended that the courses entitled "HAZWOPER" and "HAZWOPER Awareness" be held in abeyance pending further discussion.

Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Dessie Kirilova, Krannich Solar, Inc.

The Committee unanimously recommended that Ms. Kirilova's request be held in abeyance pending review by the Continuing Education sub-committee.

Additional information received from Marcel Renson regarding his request to teach Continuing Education Courses. At its September 7, 2011 meeting, the Board requested that Mr. Renson provide a more detailed description/outline of the courses to be taught.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve seven (7) new courses and instructors.

Application for Continuing Education Course/Seminar Approval received from Jay Halferty, United Inspection Agency.

The Committee unanimously recommended to approve two (2) new courses and instructors.

Mr. Schooley stated that he and Mr. Papademas attended a code related Webinar course that was six hours in length. There was some interaction with course takers and one individual commented that he was able to do other things while attending the Webinar course. Mr. Schooley also stated that the instructor was having some difficulty with the quiz portion. Mr. Schooley further stated that a power point presentation was conducted and attendees had an opportunity to raise their hand to ask a question or the attendee could text their question.

Mr. Schooley further stated that he liked the concept of the Webinar course; however, he logged off after two hours as he had a headache. Mr. Schooley stated that Mr. Papademas will share his experience taking the Webinar course at the Board's next meeting.

November 2, 2011

Mr. Schooley stated that he would like to recommend that a regulation be drafted limiting the Webinar courses to not more than two (2) hours in length.

The Committee reviewed applications for the written examination to be administered by Thomson Prometric. Twenty (20) applications were approved.

The Committee unanimously recommended to go into Executive Closed Session to consider and to review consumer complaints, investigative reports and other information received pursuant to the Board's investigative authority in order to determine whether violations of the law, including Board regulations have occurred. The results of the deliberations will be made known when and if the Board determines to initiate disciplinary action or other law enforcement action.
