

The Board of Electrical Application Phases and Timeline

<p>Phase I</p> <p>Current Timeframe: 1 – 2 weeks</p>	<p>Phase I is the estimated time between receipt of a completed application (online or paper) and the Board’s initial review of the application and supplemental documentation.</p> <p>At the conclusion of Phase I, the Board will email you and advise you of any application deficiencies.</p>
<p>Phase II</p> <p>Current Timeframe: 4 to 8 weeks–</p> <p><i>*Please note, the Board meets once a month and your application must be completed and received within 2 weeks prior to the Board’s meeting date.</i></p>	<p>Phase II is the estimated time between receipt of any deficient items (provided in your original notice in Phase I).</p> <p>*Please note Phase II is contingent on applicant takes immediate action when notified of application deficiencies. If applicant disclose criminal history the documents must be obtained regarding criminal activity and approved by both the Board and the Deputy Attorney General. This will delay the application process if the Board request additional information or if a hearing is requested.</p> <p>If no criminal history is disclosed the applicant automatically moves to Phase III.</p>
<p>Phase III</p> <p>Current Timeframe: 1 - 2 weeks</p> <p><i>Phase III - Part 1 Specifically applies to the Electrical Contractor’s exam applicants.</i></p> <p><i>Phase III - Part 2</i> <i>If applying for the Class A Journeyman, Class B Wiremen and the Class A Electrical Apprentice.</i></p>	<p>Phase III – Part 1 Is the estimated time between the receipts of exam scores any remaining deficiency documents and Board approval. *Please note applicants must pass all 3 examinations prior to obtaining board approval for licensure.</p> <p>Phase III - Part 2 Is the estimated time between Phase II and when the application is approved by the Board.</p> <p>Upon approval of your application, a Congratulations letter will be emailed to you which include information on how to obtain licensure.</p>
