The above-mentioned game is approved for use in New Jersey as an amusement game, as defined in the Amusement Game Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-100 et seq. ("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. Any modification of the manufacturer's specifications or the specified method of play immediately voids this certification.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game. This Certification of Permissibility contains three pages.

GAME DESCRIPTION

The Dizzy Chicken game is a single player arcade redemption game. The game's play field consists of a spiral track with various colored lights, a game ball and a spring loaded plunger.

The player inserts the required amount of credits into the device to initiate game play. The player activates a spring loaded plunger which is located at the player position. This allows the player to launch the game ball unto the spiral track play field of various colored lights. The color of the light which the ball lands determined the ticket value awarded. If the game ball lands on the flashing bonus prize light, the player is awarded the "Jackpot" ticket value and the opportunity to take a bonus shot for the "Super Jackpot" ticket value.

Upon completion of the game all tickets are awarded to the player for prize redemption.

CONDITIONS

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) Payout must occur immediately in the form of redemption tickets redeemable for prizes.
- 3.) Game shall be clean and free of debris.
- 4.) Game shall be installed and maintained according to manufacturer specifications.

The approved operating software version is listed below:

Software Identification

Bay Tek Games has agreed to the terms by completing the certification section #2 of the application for Amusement Game Certification Amendment. This game now has two (2) approved software versions; **version V1.0.0 & V1.1.0** and Dave & Buster's **version DC V 2.14** for the Dizzy Chicken arcade redemption game is in full compliance with the Amusement Licensing Law.
