The above-mentioned game is approved for use in New Jersey as an amusement game, as defined in the Amusement Games Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-100 et seq. ("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. Any modification of the manufacturer's specifications or the specified method of play immediately voids this certification.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game. #### GAME DESCRIPTION

The HYPERpitch game is a one or two player noncompetitive baseball pitching theme arcade redemption game. Each player position consists of a solo or versus button, a baseball catcher background target, LED score display and LED speed pitch display.

The player(s) throws three (3) baseballs one at a time into the catcher background target in an attempt to hit the catcher target utilizing speed and accuracy within the allotted amount of time displayed on the LED game clock. The players score is calculated on the speed of the pitch and the area in which hits the catcher target. The scores for each throw is added together for a final score. The player(s) is awarded tickets based upon a score and the posted game rules of play.

Upon completion of the game all tickets are dispensed to the player for prize redemption.

#### **CONDITIONS**

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) Payout must occur immediately in the form of tickets redeemable for prizes.
- 3.) Game shall be clean and free of debris.
- 4.) Game shall be installed and maintained according to manufacturer specifications.

The approved operating software version is listed below:

### **Software Identification**

LAI Games has agreed to the terms by completing the certification section #1 of the Application for Amusement Game Certification that reflects the **software version 4.02.002** for the HYPERpitch arcade redemption game. According to the manufacturer this software version is in full compliance with the Amusement Games Licensing Law.
