The above-mentioned game is approved for use in New Jersey as an amusement game, as defined in the Amusement Game Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-100 et seq. ("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. Any modification of the manufacturer's specifications or the specified method of play immediately voids this certification.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game. This Certification of Permissibility contains three pages.

GAME DESCRIPTION

The Knock Out Punch game is a boxing theme two (2) player station non competitive arcade redemption game. The object of the game is for the player to press the "Punch" button which is located at the player position in an attempt to knock down boxer figurines which move across the play field. These boxer figurines are attached to a conveyor belt which moves from right to left.

All boxer figures that are knocked down at the first player station will stand back up to allow the second player station an opportunity to knock down all boxer figurines. Each player position has a separate LED display which shows the number of boxer figurines successfully knocked down. The game then evaluates each score and awards tickets in accordance with the games posted payout schedule.

Upon completion of the game all awards are dispensed as tickets to the player for prize redemption.

CONDITIONS

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) Payout must occur immediately in the form of tickets or tokens.
- 3.) Game shall be clean and free of debris.
- 4.) Game shall be installed and maintained according to manufacturer specifications.

The approved operating software version is listed below:

Note: The software which controls the operation of the Knock Out Punch device was identified by the independent lab as **version 3.24 NJ** The software which controls the operation of the game is stored on the main CPU (Central Processing Unit) board. For software compliance purposes the software version can be verified during a power cycle. During the power cycle the games LED displays located at the player position will show the following:
