The above-mentioned game is approved for use in New Jersey as an amusement game, as defined in the Amusement Game Licensing Law, N.J.S.A. 5:8-100 et seq. ("Law"), and the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:3-1.1 et seq. ("Regulations"). This approval is based upon information supplied by the applicant at the time of application for certification. The game must be operated in accordance with the specifications submitted and the terms of this certification. Any modification of the manufacturer's specifications or the specified method of play immediately voids this certification.

It is unlawful to license or operate any amusement game in the State of New Jersey without a valid Certification of Permissibility or in a manner not in accordance with Certification of Permissibility issued for the game. This Certification of Permissibility contains three pages. This is page 1 of 3.

GAME DESCRIPTION

The Red Elephant game is a single player non competitive arcade redemption game. The Red Elephant game consists of an elephant trunk which is located on the back plain of the play field, a game ball, a ball release button which is located at the player position and slots with tickets values located at the bottom of the play field.

The object of the game is for the player to time the release of the game ball as the "elephant truck" slowly moves up and then down. Once the player presses the ball release button at the desired time, the ball will roll down the "elephant trunk" into the play field into one of the various ticket valued slots. Tickets will be issued to the player according the slot value in which the game ball lands. If the player successfully lands the game ball into the jackpot slot, the player will be awarded the value of tickets displayed on the "JACKPOT" display located at the top of the game. Upon completion of the game tickets are dispensed to the player for prize redemption.

CONDITIONS

- 1.) The maximum price to play shall not exceed values set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:3-3.4.
- 2.) Payout must occur immediately in the form of tickets redeemable for prizes.
- 3.) Game shall be clean and free of debris.
- 4.) Game shall be installed and maintained according to manufacturer specifications.

Software Identification

The operation of the Red Elephant electronic redemption game is controlled by software stored on a micro controller which is secured on the main Central Processing Unit (CPU) board. The Red Elephant **software version V.1.02** can be viewed on the "Jackpot" display located at the top of the game cabinet during a power cycle.


