Phase II Timeframe: 6 to 8 weeks Please note: Applicants who have NCEES records with MLE (Model Law Engineer) designation and have no deficiencies and/or criminal records may receive in-house approval without need for Board review.	Phase II is the estimated time for final Board review. Please note, applications requiring additional information/clarification for Board review will add 4 to 6 weeks to Phase II. *Please note, applications with criminal history or adverse actions requiring additional Board review will add an additional 4-6 weeks to Phase II. The estimated timeframe assumes the applicant will take immediate action to provide responsive documentation as requested.
Phase III Timeframe: 2 to 3 weeks	Phase III is the estimated time between approval and applicant notification. Upon approval of your application, a congratulations letter and license fee invoice will be emailed to you. Once the license fee is paid, your license number will be issued and you should receive your hard copy license in the mail within 10-15 business days.
