INFORMATIONAL / DISCUSSION ITEMS

A As many of you are already aware, the Division of Consumer Affairs has been involved in efforts to expand the pool of health care professionals that would qualify to administer COVID vaccines at the many Point of Dispensing sites that have been set up across the State. Yesterday, the Division entered three significant orders that will go a long way towards expanding those pools, including Orders: (1) recognizing certified medical assistants as qualified vaccinators; (2) recognizing medical, nursing and physician assistant students as qualified vaccinators; and (3) recognizing dentists, L.P.N.s, C.H.H.A.s, respiratory care therapists, perfusionists, podiatrists, optometrists, physical therapists, athletic trainers, and dental hygienists who hold a local anesthesia permit as qualified vaccinators. Each of the Order requires that there be a supervising physician, physician assistant, APN, or pharmacist at the POD, and delineates a series of requirements that fall to the supervising health care practitioner.
