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State Board of Professional Engineers And Land Surveyors Minutes of January 18, 2018 <u>Public Session Minutes</u>

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the State Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors was called to order by President James Valenti, at 9:03 a.m. at 124 Halsey Street, 3rd Floor, Union Conference Room, Newark, New Jersey. All parties were duly notified of the time, date and place, with all pertinent material being provided.

Gary Paparozzi was sworn in as the newest member of the Board.

ACTION: Duly noted.

II Regulations / Sunset Committee

ACTION: Liza Ackerman, Regulatory Analyst was present to discuss the draft sunset regulations. After some discussion, the following motions were made:

On a motion by BM Purcell motion, seconded by BM Vernick to amend section <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 13:40-2.2 to read "Professional experience should demonstrate to the Board that the applicant is competent to design and supervise engineering projects and works to ensure the life, health and property." BM Paparozzi abstained. Motion carried.

On a motion by BM Purcell, seconded by BM Kelly to revise <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 13:40-5.1(k) to read "Tax assessment maps for submission to and approval by the New Jersey Division of Taxation are to be prepared and revised by a licensed professional land surveyor, who is obligated to prepare and revise tax maps in full compliance with the legal requirements pertaining to such maps."

On a motion by BM Purcell, seconded by BM Vernick to remove <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 13:40-2.4(a)4 and re-number the subparagraphs accordingly. BM Paparozzi abstained and BM Smith voted no. Motion carried. Additionally, the Board voted to issue licenses to applicants seeking licensure as a professional land surveyor who met all requirements, except for passing this examination which has been suspended due to statutory and administrative constraints. However, a committee was formed to evaluate how to incorporate this examination into the national examination or by some other method.

Finally, on a motion by BM Purcell, seconded by BM Vernick to approve for publication the proposed rules with amendments for the Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors and table the section of regulations pertaining to Home Inspectors. BM Paparozzi abstained. Motion carried.

III NCEES Committee

ACTION: BM Purcell informed the Board that the Northeast Zone meeting will be held in Portland, Maine on April 17 and 18, 2018. He also reminded board members that if they are interested in volunteering to serve on a committee to submit their requests. Also that NCEES is concerned with the threats to licensure nationwide as it relates to the North Carolina decision.

IV Joint Committee

ACTION: BM Kelly reported to the Board that the Joint Committee reviewed a complaint alleging a professional engineer practiced architecture without a license. The Joint Committee determined to take no action but cautioned him to work within his scope of the practice of engineering.
