2. 2018 Annual NCEES Meeting

3. 2018/2020 Biennial Renewal Statistics

ACTION: Executive Director Leone informed the Board that as of today, 6268 (33%) Professional Engineers have renewed their licenses and 12,727 engineer licenses are still outstanding. Also as of today, 327 (38%) Professional Land Surveyor licenses have renewed and 539 land surveyor licenses are still outstanding. Licensees have until April 30 to renew without paying a late fee. As of May 1, licensees will have to pay a \$50 late fee to renew and as of June 1, 2018, licensees who did not renew must go through the reinstatement process, paying the renewal fee, a reinstatement fee and submitting proof of continuing professional competency credits. BM Smith requested the number of Professional Engineers & Land Surveyors licensed per year as well as the number of NJ residents and out-of-state licensees.

4. Executive Director Leone brought an issue to the Board for discussion.

Specifically, an individual who submitted an application to take the PE exam, was granted a waiver of the FE exam, and is registered to take the PE exam in April, has requested an EIT Certificate.

ACTION: The Board determined that the statute clearly states that an applicant for EIT certification must document graduation from a four-year program in engineering or engineering technology and successfully pass the Fundamentals of Engineering exam. The waiver from the Board does not indicate the applicant successfully passed the FE exam.

5. 2018 April Administration of PE exam

ACTION: Executive Director Leone informed the Board that 254 individuals are scheduled to take the PE exam in April. There is also no new information for the October administration of the exam.

INFORMATIONAL / DISCUSSION ITEMS

BP Valenti reported that he, BM Kelly, and ED Leone visited Rowan University, Stevens Institute of Technology, and The College of New Jersey to discuss Professional Engineer licensing with the Deans of the Engineering programs.

BP Valenti and ED Leone also visited with New Jersey Institute of Technology's Dean Moshe Kam to discuss professional licensing and to learn about NJIT's program. Dean Kam informed them that awareness of the land surveying profession among students needs to be addressed as the number of graduates of the program have dwindled to approximately eleven (11) per year. Dean Kam advised that NJIT does not require students to sit for the FE exam.

BM Smith raised the issue of the Land Surveyors' State Specific Exam. BP Valenti agreed to discuss this issue with BM Smith before the next meeting and requested this issue be placed on the April agenda for further discussion.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Michael Williams, an applicant for PE licensure, was present at the meeting and submitted a copy of a letter from ABET regarding his two-year associate's degree in engineering. The Board advised Mr. Williams that he should have his associate's degree evaluated by one of the Board's recommended credentials evaluation services which are listed on the Board's website, to determine if his degree is substantially equivalent to an ABET accredited four-year degree or to document any deficiencies required for equivalency.

The Board, on a motion by BM Vernick, seconded by BM Cleary, unanimously voted to go into Executive Session for the purposes of reviewing the minutes and other items on the agenda.
