**ACTION:** The Board reviewed this pending legislation and concluded to take no position at this time. It will continue to monitor its movement.

II Regulations / Sunset Committee

Liza Ackerman appeared before the Board and advised that (1) due to the complexity of the proposed rule changes and (2) the general policy that substantial changes should not be made during sunset and (3) the short time period remaining to complete the various approvals required to publish and adopt the regulations, she recommended that the current regulations be adopted at Sunset without Change. This was further discussed by DAGs Michelle Albertson and Olga Bradford. DAG Albertson also advised that the sunset Regulations would include a specific statement that the Board intended to proceed with publication substantive changes as soon as possible. The Board President asked for firm dates for future action and was advised that the likely timeframe would have the amended regulations published in calendar year 2018.

**ACTION:** On Motion by BM Smith, Second by Vice President Kelly, the Board voted to readopt the existing regulations without changes, and to proceed with the amended regulations as soon as possible with the goal to publish the amended regulations in 2018.
