Further discussion resulted in the committee to schedule a meeting with Mehnaz Rahim, Regulatory Analyst, Division of Consumer Affairs, to discuss a possible regulation change pertaining to continuing education credits, limit the number of hours that can be obtained in a 24 hour period. This discussion will cover both Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors continuing education regulations.

## III Legislation Committee

4/20/2023 Bill A-5283 which requires calculation of national average time needed to approve applications for initial credential in profession or occupation and use of average time as standard in New Jersey.

**ACTION:** Mehnaz Rahim, Regulatory Analyst, Division of Consumer Affairs, was present to discuss this legislation with the Board. After hearing the summary of the legislation, the Board strongly oppose this legislation as it appears to be absurdly misguided. The Board has limited resources; the bill does not take into consideration that some States have fewer applicants applying for licensure versus states with large number of applicants applying for

licensure. The Bill also does not determine when the application period starts as applications don't come into the board office complete with all documents, sometimes additional information is required to make a determination, sometime information submitted is not sufficient.

### **IV NCEES Committee**

**ACTION:** BP Purcell reported that NCEES Zone meetings will be held next week and he and BM Alsharaa will be attending and representing New Jersey at the Zone meetings. NCEES will hold State of the Council meetings prior to Annual Meeting scheduled to take place in Boston in August.
