CALL TO ORDER

Notice of the scheduled the June 16, 2022 meeting of the New Jersey State Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors was not held at 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey, but remotely. The meeting was called to order by President James Valenti at 9:03 am and conducted virtually.

REVIEW OF MINUTES

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

A General Report

- 1 Joseph Grabowy, Senior Mgt. Assistant, for the Board informed the Board that he will be retiring at the end of this month. He expressed his pleasure working with the board over the past 23 years. The Board members thanked Joe for his service and guidance to the Board over the years.
- 2 Executive Director Miller informed the Board that he administered the state specific examination to a total of 7 applicants; 4 were repeat takers who passed the exam and 3 were first time takers who failed the exam. The pass rate was 86%. The next administration of the test is August 9, 2022.
- 3 Executive Director Miller informed the Board that the staff will continue to review the applications for completeness and reach out to the applicant for missing items. The complete application then will be uploaded to The Box for board member review. An Activity Task item has been added for the board member to either approve or reject the application. Also all previously reviewed application will be moved into a Reviewed folder, so that it is still accessible but will not take up the board members file.

- B Standing motion review/approval next agenda
 The Board hereby authorizes the Board President to take action regarding certain events
 arising between Board meetings, where time is of the essence. Such actions include:
 - 1 Issuing an Order to Show Cause upon the filing by the Attorney General of a Verified Complaint seeking emergent relief;
 - 2 To call a meeting of a committee of the Board to conduct an emergent Temporary Suspension hearing based upon such Complaint and issuing an Order to be ratified by the Board at its next meeting and having immediate effect, or call a meeting of the full Board to conduct an emergent Temporary Suspension hearing based upon such Complaint and issuing an Order having immediate effect;
 - 3 Determining settlement terms of a disciplinary case pending review and approval of the full board, including but not limited to, those cases where a final determination by the board must be made on short notice to effectuate global settlement with other civil or criminal authorities or where there is an immediate danger to the public health safety and welfare should a licensee remain in practice; and
 - 4 Approving minutes in case a meeting is cancelled.

The above actions are subject to review by the full Board at the next meeting. The full Board may then ratify, amend or vacate the action taken by the President. Further, the Board hereby authorizes the Executive Director of the Board to approve applications from applicants seeking to be licensed and/or certified that meet the statutory and regulatory requirements; and upon meeting all requirements, issue said license and/or certification.

ACTION: After reviewing the standing motion, the Board, on a motion by BM Vernick, seconded by BM Kelly, unanimously voted to approve the standing motion as presented.

 - I Legislation Committee

ACTION: A3290/S1730 which requires professional licensing boards to issue licenses for certain individuals with good standing licenses or certification in other jurisdictions under certain circumstances. BM Vernick informed the Board that this Bill passed the Assembly and was referred to the Senate commerce Committee on June 2, 2022. The Board will review this bill at the next meeting.

II Application & Examination Committee

ACTION: BP Purcell requested BM Valenti continue to work with the Executive Director in this capacity.
